

Questions to Ask Prospective Contractors

Finding the right contractor for your project can be challenging. Asking some of the questions below can help you to find the right contractor for your project.

- Do you have prior experience with this type of project?
- What is your educational background?
- Do you have any certifications or special training? (arborist, pesticide applicator, etc.)
- Are you insured and, if so, can I have a copy of your proof of insurance?
- What impact will this project have on the surrounding area?
- What is your timeline for the project?
- Do you charge for an estimate?
- Do you require a deposit? If so, how much?
- Do you plan to subcontract all or part of the project to someone else?
- What guarantees can you give me?
- Will you provide a written contract?
