Minutes of October 20, 2025

The regular scheduled Trustee meeting called to order at 7:00 PM with the pledge of Allegiance. In attendance: Matt Combs, Walter Rollin, Jed Lamb, Robert Holmes, Sheila Lanning, Amanda Jerore and David Walters. *Motion* by Holmes with a second by Rollin to approve the minutes of the October 6, 2025 regular scheduled meeting as written. Roll call: three yeas. Checks 11150-11155 and payments totaling \$6,633.02 were approved for payment.

Previously tabled *Resolution 2025-13* pertaining to the Kozik property and removal of junk vehicles was discussed further and remained tabled. Rollin: contacted Sugar Ridge and Vaughn towing but they could not quote a price for removal of the vehicles. *Resolution 2025-9* pertaining to a policy for indigent burials within the Township also remained tabled. Lamb: talked to Eastman Funeral home and a policy could state the amount the Township is willing to pay for an indigent burial. This amount can be set in a policy or with the annual fees passed in January of each year. Rollin to contact Eastman also.

PUBLIC COMMENTS- Amanda Jerore explained that Murray Ridge can scan the two boxes of Cemetery documents and probably not cost close to the \$1,000.00 authorized for the work. They will pick up the boxes and return them with the scanning complete. After discussion it was decided to scan the documents to pdf files and use a USB drive for the storage of them. Lanning: if Amanda needs a USB or PDF software let her know. David Walters of Route 162 questioned what can be done about water flooding and taking out culverts. Combs: can provide with Ohio District of Transportation phone number. Walters: neighbor Bruce Hager's culvert was recently flooded.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

WATER- Lamb: meeting attended two meetings, planning committee went well, hydrants are being maintenance. Informed them we would like the reports of the hydrant maintenance. The training in New Orleans was good, earned enough training points to qualify for the National Rural Water Association Leadership Board quiz. Will complete the quiz soon.

LORCO- Lamb: meeting was fine, still reviewing 6119 Board information, LORCO will decide later about joining the County 6119 Board.

AMBULANCE- Holmes: Miles for September 4,333, Year to date 38,907. Runs for September 148, year to date 1385. Huntington September runs 13, year to date 102. 1 overdose

FIRE- Rollin: very concerned with the doing away with property taxes, chili cook off is 11/1/2025 at 1:00-5:00 PM at the Eagles.

SHERIFF- Lamb= called Sheriff on pick up parked too close to route 58 for some time. Sheriff knocked on door but no one answered.

OPWC/SWAC- Combs: Moskal ditch work pushed back to next year. Looking at getting a mini grant to clean out 930 feet of ditch on McMillan.

CEMETERY- Rollin: Burial Monday, no word from Lewis Land Professionals on new Cemetery layout.

ROADS- Combs: Some patching still to complete, Rochester Road work done. Hope to get 6 more loads to hold the roads together.

EQUIPMENT- Combs: scrapped road roller. Trustees asked Lanning to inform them what funds the money from scrapped material was posted.

RECYCLE- Holmes: 152 tons of recycled agricultural tires received by county. Dumpster day went well.
