## This is the Lord's camp. Please leave it cleaner than you found it.

- NO PETS allowed in any part of the camp.
- STRENGTH OF THE YOUTH DRESS GUIDELINES is required & to be modeled by all.
- NO SMOKING, VAPING, DRUGS OR ALCOHOL permitted in Camp.
- NON-MEMBER GUESTS need to be informed by you & follow the rules of the camp.
- WATERFRONT SAFETY requires youth to be accompanied by an adult. FREE RANGE
  youth time encouraged, yet you are fully responsible for your kid's safety & actions.
- WATERFRONT EQUIPMENT is randomly used by loosely organized family groups and each family needs to return the equipment they used when finished. Life jackets & paddles are to be kept off the ground and hung up before leaving. For temporary parking of canoes and kayaks, pull them up out of the water & leave the paddles inside the craft. Watercraft is to be entered only when the craft is floating in water.
- WATER TOYS need to be respected and cared for to last. Follow the rules posted.
- WATERFRONT CAMPFIRE PIT and area needs to be kept clean of litter & woodchips.
- BEACH TIME Keep your space contained so more people can join in. Pick up garbage and small litter after your picnic and kids. Be the inspector in your own space.
- Campfire singalongs accompanied by soft acoustic instruments are appropriate. Quiet time 11:00 7:00. Please respect other campers and our good neighbors.
- DUMPSTER is located next to the archery range. GREY WATER PIT is by the Shelter.
- WOOD CHOPPING is done only on the BLOCK provided by the woodsheds. Clean up wood chips and stack wood neatly in shed or at the back of your campsite.
- FIRE PITS are not garbage cans. Place all garbage in the garbage bin. Before you leave, let your fire burn down, then add water to cool the coals so the fire pit is ready for the next campers.
- PICNIC TABLES can be moved but returned to the back of each site. Stack wood and pick up litter.
- CAMP INSPECTION by Camp Wardens needs to happen before you leave. Please leave it cleaner than you found it. Call 780-238-7777 for inspection.
- ZIP LINE will be available for family use on a schedule arranged with the Warden once a
  day for 2 hours. Three (3) adults need to commit to an orientation and then supervise
  for the duration. On completion they will collect the Zip line gear into the bin and
  return it to the shop. All other age appropriate youth in the family camp are free to join
  in.
