
This is where we are

From the Junction of Anthony Henday Dr and Hwy 16 on the west side of Edmonton go west 59 km to the Village of Wabamun exit (324) South into Wabamun to the 4 way stop (50 Ave)
West for 8 km to Range Road 50

Most of the camp is on the south side of the road.

Cold water all year






The Lion's Den

The Fox Den


Immediately adjacent to the B-P Lodge.

Cooking utensils for 20 campers


Hot and cold water all year.


Hiking The Hoo Doo's

Camp Reservation Policy

- Stakes, Wards, youth groups, families and Scout groups can request camp bookings before January 1 of each year.
- These requests will be posted on the public Google calendar. <u>bit.ly/Tannercalendar</u>
- On January 1, the bookings will be processed. If more than one group has requested the same time, the following booking priority will be used:
 - 1. 2 major camps that we have agreed to with Scouts Canada
 - 2. LDS Stakes
 - 3. LDS Unit youth groups (YW, YM, Primary)
 - 4. LDS Unit ward/branch groups (i.e. Ward Camps, father/son, etc.)
 - 5. LDS Families
 - 6. LDS Units outside of Edmonton Temple District
 - 7. Community Scout groups
 - 8. Other Non-Profit Youth Groups.
- After Jan 1, units can book available space on an "as available" basis.
- Gary will accommodate booking requests for the same time as much as possible within the camp geography and around site capacities.
