## **Zip Line Orientation**

3 supervisors are required at all times.

1 Launch supervisor
1 Harness & Helmet assistant
1 Unloading assistant

## **Pre - Activity Instructions**

Supervisors are responsible for setting up and taking down the zip line equipment

- Attaching the Trolley
- Attaching the Brake Bungee

NO access to the launch pad is allowed at any time unless the launch supervisor is on the launch pad.

All riders must use a harness and helmet, worn correctly.

Long hair must be covered or tied up. No hoodies or shirts/jackets with long string ties.

The weight limit for this zip line is 150#.

Setup of zip line to be reviewed by Camp Staff before zip line is used.

## **Loading and Unloading Instructions**

Harness and helmet assistant to ensure harnesses and helmets are worn correctly

The next rider does not climb onto the pad until the previous rider has launched.

Only the launch supervisor and 1 rider on the pad at one time.

Launch supervisor on the launch pad must wear a safety harness and tied off to anchor point. Launch supervisor will hook up safety lanyard to the harness of the rider.

Launch supervisor to provide visual inspection that harness and helmet are worn correctly Short riders will need to stand on the riser to load safely.

The zip line seat will be restrained by the launch restraint hook until rider is loaded and ready to launch. This will prevent premature launching of the rider.

Except for the rider returning the seat, the glide path must remain free of pedestrians at all times.

## **Post Activity Instructions**

Trolley and the brake bungee to be removed immediately after completion of activity and returned to Camp Staff, complete with harnesses and helmets
