Register using your email or phone number at <u>tricountyemergencyalert.</u> genasys.com/portal.



Create a contact in your phone for Tri-County Emergency Alerts. This will ensure alert messages are not blocked.

Phone alerts will show up on Caller ID as 435-393-0593
Text/SMS messages will show up from Sender ID 65513
Emails will come from Duchesne County Alerts
(noreply@genasys.com)

Configure your account settings in each tab on the left.

Add additional email addresses
and phone numbers.
Add locations and relatives.
Choose which types of alerts you

want to receive, and via which

channels.

Daggett, Duchesne, and Uintah Counties will use the Genasys ALERT notification system to alert residents about issues that may affect their safety, such as wildfires, floods, gas leaks, power outages, and other emergencies. The Genasys ALERT system is a multi-channel (i.e. SMS, voice, email, etc.) communication solution that provides lifesaving emergency information. To ensure you receive this information, keep your contact information up to date.

To update your contact information, log into your account at tricounty emergencyalert.genasys.com/portal.
