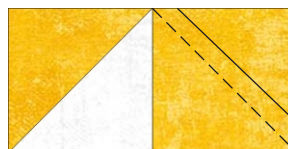
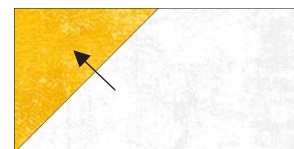
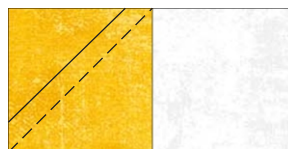


Cutting Directions

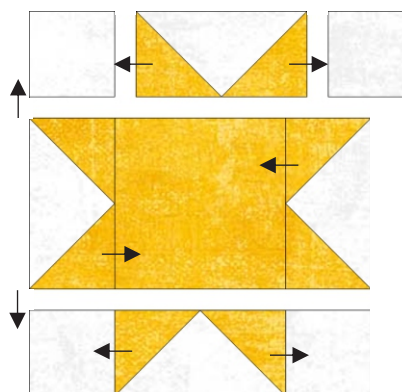
- From White Background cut:
 - (2) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" (I)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" (G)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" (F)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" (E)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" (D)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" (C)
 - (13) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" (B)
 - (13) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" (A)
- From Green cut:
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" (H)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" (G)
- From Asst Pinks & Red cut:
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" (F)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" (E)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" (D)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" (C)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" (B)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" (A)
- From Yellow cut:
 - (3) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" (J)
 - (24) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" (A)

Piecing Instructions

- Make a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (24) Yellow "A" as shown.
- Layer (1) Yellow "A" on top of (1) White "B" Rectangle (Left side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow.
- Layer (1) Yellow "A" on top of the previous "B" Rectangle (Right side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Flying Geese Unit. Flying Geese unit should measure 1-1/2" x 2-1/2"
- Repeat previous (4) steps to make a total of
 - (12) Flying Geese Units



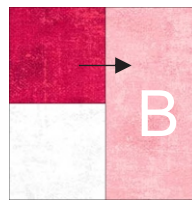
- Layout:
 - (4) White Bkgd "A" - (1) Yellow "J"
 - (4) Flying Geese as shown
- Sew units together into rows, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Star Block. Star Block should measure 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (3) Star Blocks.



- Layer (1) White Bkgd "A" Square with (1) Asst Pink /Red "B" square as shown.
Sew units together and press towards "B".

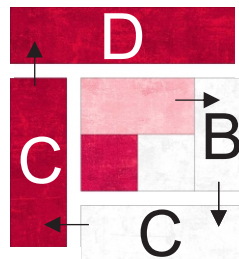


- Turn block **counter-clockwise** and layer (1) Asst Pink/Red "C" rectangle onto the AB Unit. Sew the Assorted "C" rectangle on and press towards "C". Block should measure 2-1/2" x 2-1/2"



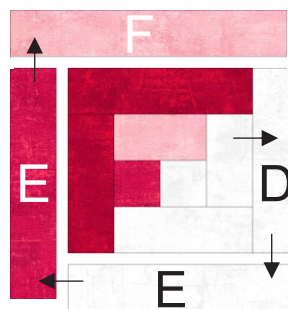
NOTE: You will turn the block counter clockwise a quarter turn after each seam so the unit you just sewed on is at the top. Then layer the next piece on the right hand side of the block and sew. Make sure to keep the block looking scrappy

- Turn block **counter-clockwise** and layout:
 - (1) White Bkgd "B" - (1) White Bkgd "C"
 - (1) Pink/Red "C" - (1) Pink/Red "D" as shown.



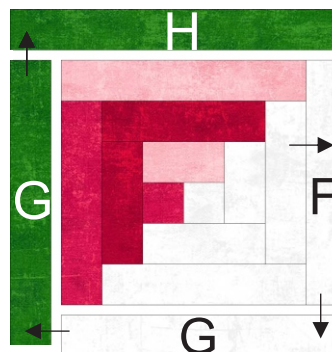
- Sew units together, in alphabetical order, pressing seam in the direction of the arrows.

- Turn block **counter-clockwise** and layout:
 - (1) White Bkgd "D" - (1) White Bkgd "E"
 - (1) Pink/Red "E" - (1) Pink/Red "F" as shown.



- Sew units together, in alphabetical order, pressing seam in the direction of the arrows.

- Turn block **counter-clockwise** and layout:
 - (1) White Bkgd "F" - (1) White Bkgd "G"
 - (1) Green "G" - (1) Green "H" as shown.



- Sew units together, in alphabetical order, pressing seam in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Log cabin Block.

- Layout: - (2) White Bkgd "I" - (3) Star Blocks
- (1) Log Cabin Block as shown

- Sew units together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) August Block.
Block should measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2"
