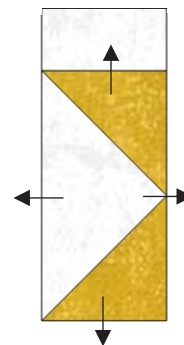
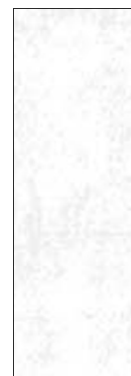
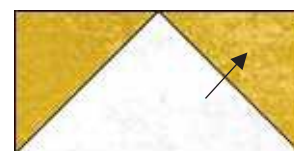
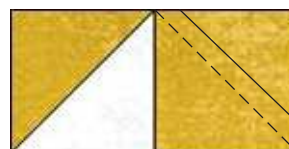
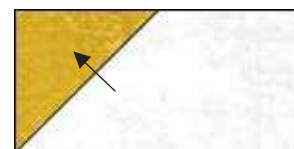
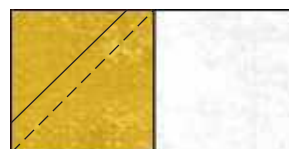
Cutting Directions

- From White Background cut:
 - (2) 2-1/2" x 5" (K)
 - (2) 2-1/2" x 4" (I)
 - (4) 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" (G)
 - (2) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" (E)
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" (N)
 - (2) 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" (M)
 - (3) 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" (D)
 - (3) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" (B)
 - (6) 1-1/2" x 1" (C)
- From Brown cut:
 - (1) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" (A)
- For **each** of (3) Assorted Scraps cut:
 - (2) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" (B)
- From Yellow
 - (3) 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" (B)
 - (6) 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" (A)
- From Assorted Greens
 - (1) 2-1/2" x 9-1/2" (F)
 - (2) 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" (H)
 - (1) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" (J)
 - (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (L)

Piecing Instructions

- Make a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (6) Yellow "A" as shown.
- Layer (1) Yellow "A" on top of (1) White "B" Rectangle (Left side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow.
- Layer (1) Yellow "A" on top of the previous "B" Rectangle (Right side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Flying Geese Unit. Flying Geese unit should measure 1-1/2" x 2-1/2"
- Repeat previous (4) steps to make a total of (3) Flying Geese units.
- Layout:

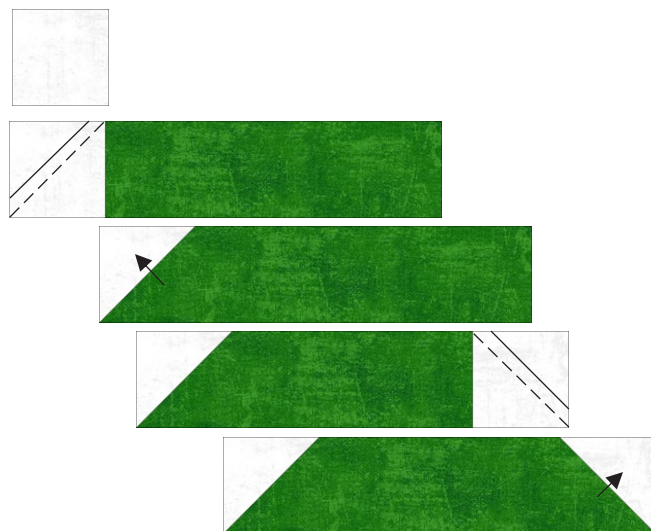
(1) Flying Geese Unit	(2) White "C"
(1) White "D"	(1) Yellow "B"
(2) Matching Asst "B" as shown	
- Sew Units together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Present unit. Unit should measure 3-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- Repeat previous (2) steps to make a total of (3) Presents



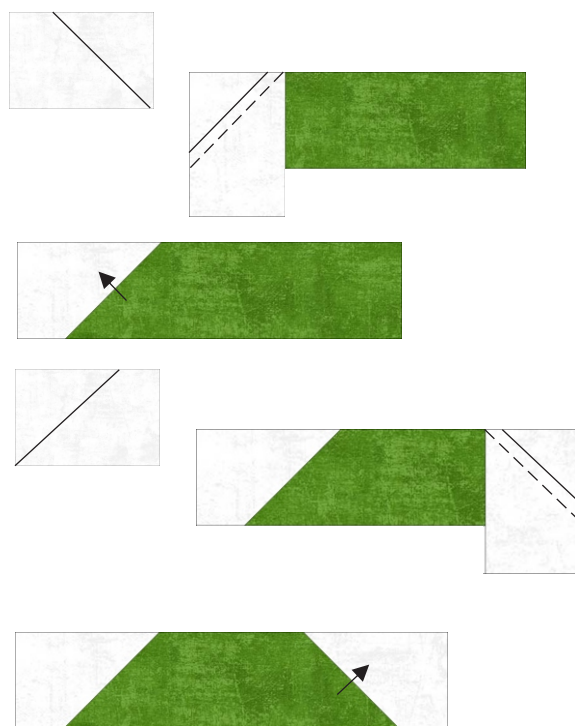
- Layout (3) Presents as shown.
- Sew units together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Stacked Present unit.
Unit should measure 3-1/2" x 12-1/2"



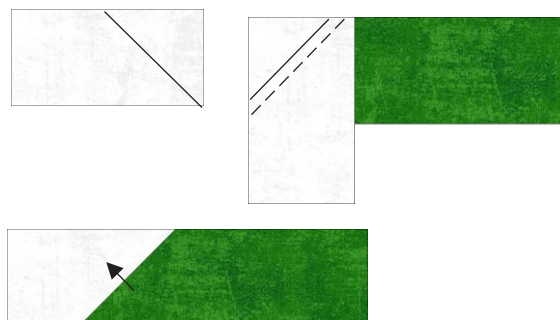
- Make a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of (2) White "E" as shown.
- Layer (1) White "E" on top of (1) Green "F" Rectangle (Left side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow.
- Layer (1) White "E" on top of the previous "F" Rectangle (Right side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Unit A.
Unit A should measure 2-1/2" x 9-1/2".



- Mark a diagonal line (45 degree angle) on the wrong side of (1) White "G" Rectangle as shown.
- Layer the "G" rectangle on the left side of (1) Green "H" rectangle as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line and press in the direction of the arrow.
- Mark a diagonal line (45 degree angle) on the wrong side of (1) White "G" Rectangle as shown.
- Layer the "G" rectangle on the Right side of the Green "H" rectangle as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line and press in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Unit B.
Unit B should measure 2-1/2" x 9-1/2"
- Repeat previous (6) steps to make a total of (2) Unit B.



- Mark a diagonal line (45 degree angle) on the wrong side of (1) White "I" Rectangle as shown.
- Layer the "I" rectangle on the left side of (1) Green "J" rectangle as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line and press in the direction of the arrow.



- Mark a diagonal line (45 degree angle) on the wrong side of (1) White "I" Rectangle as shown.



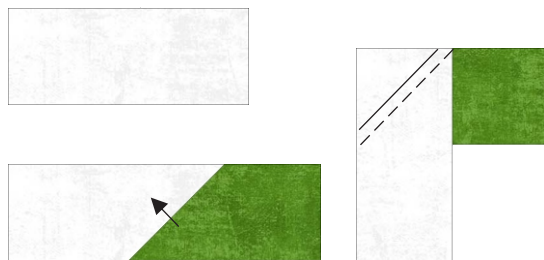
- Layer the "I" rectangle on the Right side of the Green "J" rectangle as shown.

- Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line and press in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Unit C. Unit C should measure 2-1/2" x 9-1/2"



- (1) White "K" Rectangle as shown.

- Layer the "K" rectangle on the left side of (1) Green "L" rectangle as shown.



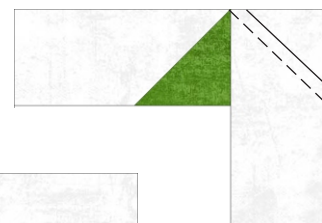
- Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line and press in the direction of the arrow.



- Mark a diagonal line (45 degree angle) on the wrong side of (1) White "K" Rectangle as shown.



- Layer the "K" rectangle on the Right side of the Green "L" rectangle as shown.



- Sew on the drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from the sewn line and press in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Unit D. Unit D should measure 2-1/2" x 9-1/2"



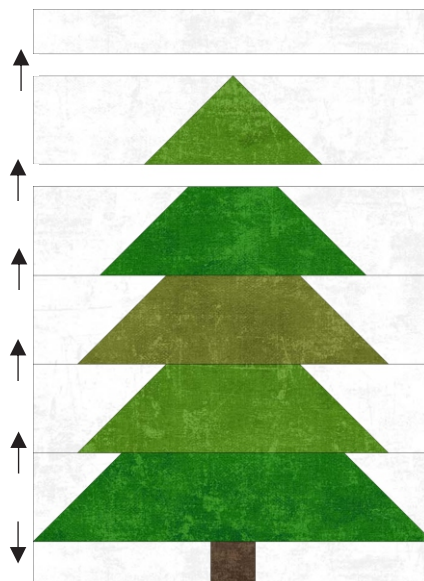
- Layout (2) White "M" and (1) Brown "A" as shown.

- Sew units together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Unit E. Unit E should measure 1-1/2" x 9-1/2"



- Layout: (1) Unit E (1) Unit A (2) Unit B (1) Unit C (1) Unit D (1) White "N" as shown

- Sew Units together, pressing seams in the direction of arrows to make (1) Tree Unit. Tree Unit should measure 9-1/2" x 12-1/2"



- Layout: - (1) Stacked Present (1) Tree Unit
- Sew units together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) December Block.
Block should measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2"
