Housekeeping:

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Things to know before you begin


Fabric yardage and cutting was based on 40"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics. All measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance, unless stated differently in the directions.

- WOF - Width of Fabric
- LOF - Length of Fabric
- HST - Half Square Triangle
- QST - Quarter Square Triangle
- FG - Flying Geese

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. Read through the instructions before beginning your project. All directions have been tested and are presented in good faith, but no warranty can be given nor results guaranteed.




Assorted Fat Quarters or Scraps Totaling 2-1/2 yards (5) Green (3) Blue (4) Teal/Aqua (3) Purple (5) Red/Pink (3) Yellow/Gold (3) Orange/Peach (2) Grey (1) Cream (1) Tan (1) Brown	

Above is what FQ's I used for my sample. It is way more than required and I used varying amounts of each. Some I used almost all and others very little.



Sashing/Borders 2 yards	
Binding 2/3 yards	
Backing 4 yards (40" wide) 2 yards (108" Wide)
