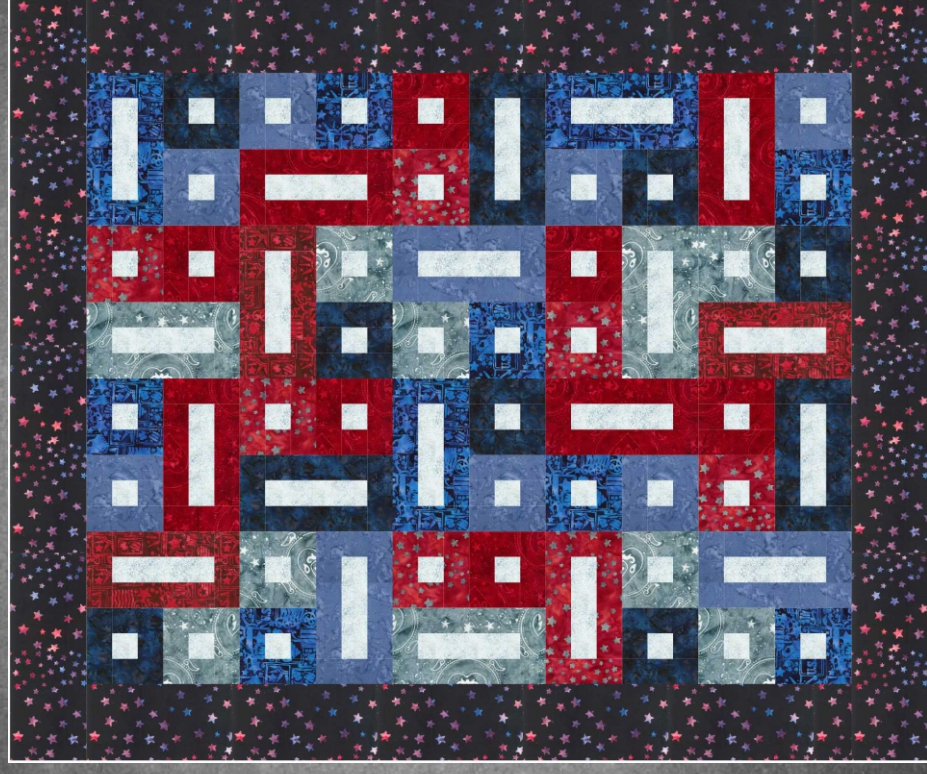

### Supplies Needed

- (40) 2-1/2" x WOF Strips **or** (1) Jelly Roll
- Background 3/4 yard
- Outer Border/Binding 1-1/2 yards
- Backing 4 yards
- Batting 70" x 8"
- Piecing thread



### Things to Know \*Before you Begin\*

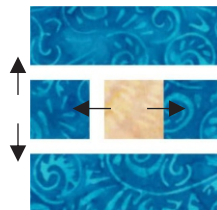
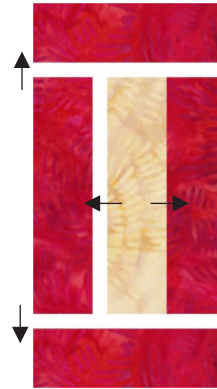
All Quantities and cuts are based on 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics. All measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance, unless stated differently in the directions. WOF stands for Width of Fabric. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. Read through the instructions before beginning your project. All directions have been tested and are presented in good faith, but no warranty can be given nor results guaranteed. I truly hope you have fun with your project!

### Cutting Directions

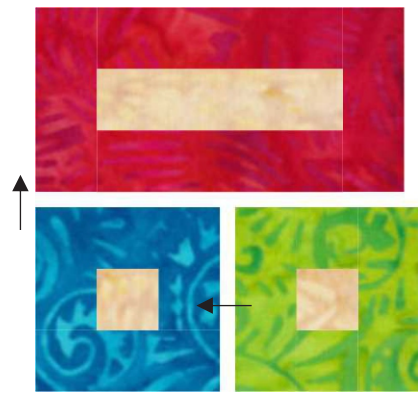
- From Accent fabric cut:
  - (20) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Rectangles (A)
  - (40) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" Squares (D)
- From **each of** (20) 2-1/2" x WOF Jelly Roll strips cut:
  - (2) 8-1/2" x 2-1/2" Rectangles (B)
  - (2) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" Rectangles (C)
- From **each of** (20) 2-1/2" x WOF Jelly Roll strips cut:
  - (4) 6-1/2" x 2-1/2" Rectangles (E)
  - (4) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" Squares (F)
- From Outer Border/Binding fabric cut:
  - (6) 6" x WOF Strips
  - (7) 2-1/2" x WOF Strips

### Piecing Instructions

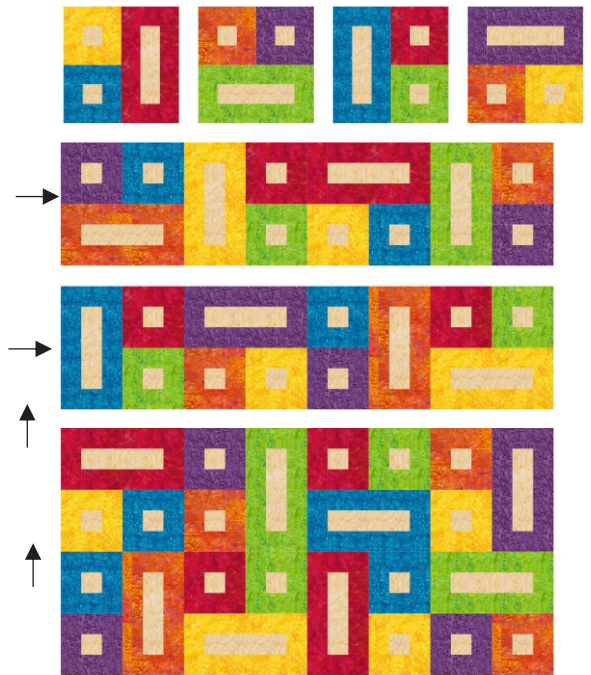
- Layout (1) Accent "A" Rectangle, (2) Assorted "B" Rectangles, and (2) Assorted "C" Rectangles as shown.
- Sew units together into rows pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Block A.  
Block A should measure 6-1/2" x 12-1/2"
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (20) Block A.
- Layout (1) Accent "D" Square, (2) Assorted "E" Rectangles, and (2) Assorted "F" squares as shown.
- Sew units together into rows pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Block B.  
Block B should measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2"
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (40) Block B.



- Layout (1) Block A and (2) Block B as shown.
- Sew units together into rows pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Block C.  
Block C should measure 12-1/2" x 12-1/2"
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (20) Block C.



- Layout (20) Block C as shown.



- Sew blocks into rows, pressing seam in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrow to make quilt center.
- Sew the (6) Outer Border strips together along the short end to make one long strip.
- Measure down the center of your quilt lengthwise and cut (2) border strips to this length
- Sew borders to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press towards the Outer Border
- Measure through the center of your quilt widthwise and cut (2) borders to this length.
- Sew borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press towards the Outer Border.
- Quilt Bind and Enjoy!
