Piecing Instructions

- Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the backside of (2) Background 3” x 3” squares as shown.
- Layer (1) Background 3” x 3” square on top of (1) Fabric 8 3” x 3” square as shown.
- Sew 1/4” seam on both sides of the drawn line.
- Cut in half on the diagonal line. Press towards the Fabric 8 triangle. Square Blocks up to 2-1/2” x 2-1/2”
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (4) Fabric 8 HSTs.
- Layout (1) Background 1-1/2” x 2-1/2” Rectangle and (1) Fabric 7 1-1/2” x 2-1/2” Rectangle as shown.
- Sew rectangles together along the long side, pressing towards Fabric 7 to make (1) Pieced Square. Pieced Square should measure 2-1/2” x 2-1/2”
- Repeat previous (2) steps to make a total of (4) Pieced Squares.
- Layout: (1) Background 2-1/2” x 2-1/2” Squares, (4) Fabric 8 HST, and (4) Pieced Squares as shown.
- Sew units into rows, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the same direction to make (1) Churn Dash Block. Block should measure 6-1/2” x 6-1/2”.
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (7) Churn Dash Blocks
- Layout (2) Churn Dash Blocks as shown.
- Sew blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Left Churn Dash Unit. Unit should measure 6-1/2” x 12-1/2”



- Layout (5) Churn Dash Blocks as shown.

- Sew blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Right Churn Dash Unit.
Unit should measure 6-1/2" x 30-1/2"
