

Piecing Instructions


- Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the backside of (56)
 Background 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" squares as shown.
 - Layer (1) Background "A" Square on top of (1) Assorted
- Rectangle (left side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow.
- Layer (1) Background Square on top of (1) Assorted Rectangle (right side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrows, to make (1) Flying Geese Unit. Flying Geese Unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"
- Repeat previous (4) steps with to make a total of (28) Assorted Flying Geese Units.
- Layer (1) Background 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" square in the lower half of (1) Flying Geese Unit as shown.
- Sew the Background Square on to the Flying Geese Unit with a partial seam. Start sewing in the middle of the background Square and sew out to the raw edge. Press in the direction of the arrow.
- Attach (1) Flying Geese Unit to the Bottom of the previous step and press in the direction of the arrow.
- Attach (1) Flying Geese Unit to the Right of the previous step and press in the direction of the arrow.
- Attach (1) Flying Geese Unit to the Top of the previous step and press in the direction of the arrow.
- Finish sewing first seam to make (1) Double Dutch Unit. Unit should measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".
- Repeat previous (6) steps to make a total of (7) Double Dutch Units.
























- Layout (2) Double Dutch Blocks as shown.
- Sew blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Left Double Dutch Unit.
 Unit should measure 6-1/2" x 12-1/2"



- Layout (5) Double Dutch Blocks as shown.
- Sew blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrow to make
 (1) Right Double Dutch Unit.
 Unit should measure 6-1/2" x 30-1/2"
