



Color Chart Reference - Cutting Garlic Knots

The "Goosus Interruptus" Sampler was created with Banyan Batik Essentials, below you find SKU's for the fabric used.

Fabric 1 81300-86 3/8 yard		(8) 2" x 2"
Fabric 2 81000-782 3/8 yard		(8) 2" x 2"
Fabric 3 81000-633 3/8 yard		(2) 2" x 2"
Fabric 4 81000-56 3/8 yard		(8) 2" x 2"
Fabric 5 81300-85 3/8 yard		(6) 2" x 2"
Fabric 6 81300-94 1/4 yard		(8) 2" x 2"
Fabric 7 81000-625 1/4 yard		(8) 2" x 2"

“Garlic Knots”

6” x 6” Finished

Piecing Instructions

- Layout: (4) Background 2” x 2” Squares,
(2) Background 2” x 3-1/2” Rectangles,
(6) Fabric 1 Squares, and
(2) Fabric 2 Squares as shown.
- Sew units into rows, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the same direction to make (1) Garlic Knots Block.
Block should measure 6-1/2” x 6-1/2”.
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (7) Garlic Knots Blocks.
- Layout (2) Garlic Knot blocks as shown.
- Sew blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Left Garlic Unit.
Unit should measure 6-1/2” x 12-1/2”
- Layout (5) Garlic Knot blocks as shown.
- Sew blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Right Garlic Unit.
Unit should measure 6-1/2” x 30-1/2”
