Piecing Instructions


- Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the backside of: (14) Background 2-1/2" squares (14) Background 2" Squares (14) Assorted 2-1/2" Squares (14) Assorted 2" Squares as shown.
- Layout (1) Assorted 2-1/2" Square in the Upper Left hand Corner of (1) Background 3-1/2" Square as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow.
- Layout (1) Assorted 2" Square in the Lower Right hand Corner of the previous Background 3-1/2" Square as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow. to make (1) Light Unit. Unit should measure 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Repeat previous (4) Steps to make a total of (14) Light Units.
- Repeat previous steps to make (14) Dark Units. Press towards the Dark.
- Layout (2) Light Units and (2) Dark Units as shown. Pay attention that the 2" squares are all pointed to the center.
- Sew units into rows, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the same direction to make (1) Hourglass Block.
 Block should measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2".
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (7) Hourglass Blocks
- Layout (2) Hourglass Blocks as shown.
- Sew blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Left Hourglass 1 Unit. Unit should measure 6-1/2" x 12-1/2"



















- Layout (5) Hourglass Blocks as shown.
- Sew blocks together, pressing in the direction of the arrow to make
 (1) Right Hourglass Unit. Unit should measure 6-1/2" x 30-1/2"
