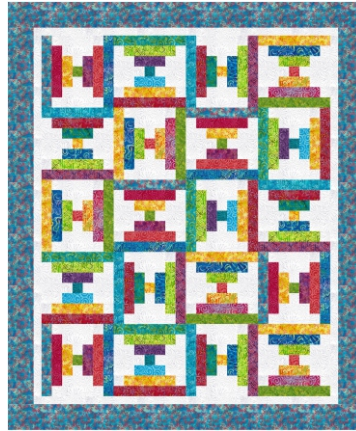


# "JELLY ROLL HOUR GLASS"

69" x 83"

## Supplies Needed

- (40) 2-1/2" x WOF Strips **or** (1) Jelly Roll
- Background 2 yards
- Outer Border/Binding 2-1/4 yards
- Backing 4 yards
- Batting 80" x 90"
- Piecing thread



- All Quantities and cuts are based on 40" wide, 100% cotton fabrics.
- All measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.
- Read through the instructions before beginning your project.
- WOF – Width of Fabric.
- LOF – Length of Fabric
- All directions have been tested and are presented in good faith.

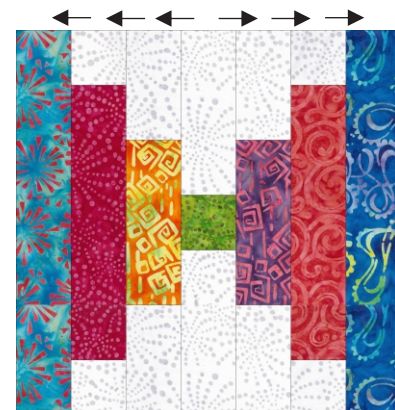
## Cutting Directions

- From Background fabric cut:
  - (40) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" (C)
  - (80) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (D)
  - (80) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" (E)
  - (7) 2" x WOF (Inner Border)
- From (40) Assorted Jelly Roll Strips cut a total of:
  - (40) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" (A)
  - (40) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" (B)
  - (40) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" (C)
  - (20) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" (E)
- From Border/Binding Fabric cut:
  - (4) 5-1/2" x LOF (Outer Border)
  - (4) 2-1/2" x LOF (Binding)

## Piecing Instructions

- Layout:
 

(2) Assorted "A" Strips	(2) Background "E" Squares
(2) Assorted "B" Strips	(2) Background "D" Strips
(2) Assorted "C" Strips	(2) Background "C" Strips
(1) Assorted "E" Square as shown.	
- Sew units together into vertical rows, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew vertical rows together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Hour Glass Block. Block should measure 14-1/2" x 14-1/2"
- Repeat previous (3) Steps to make a total of (20) Hour Glass Blocks.



- Layout (20) Hour Glass Blocks as shown.

- Sew blocks into rows, pressing seam in the direction of the arrows.

- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrow to make quilt center.

- Sew the (6) Inner Border strips together along the short end to make one long strip.

- Measure down the center of your quilt lengthwise and cut (2) Inner border strips to this length

- Sew borders to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press towards the Inner Border

- Measure through the center of your quilt widthwise and cut (2) Inner Borders to this length.

- Sew borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press towards the Inner Border.

- Measure down the center of your quilt lengthwise and cut (2) Outer Border strips to this length

- Sew borders to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press towards the Outer Border

- Measure through the center of your quilt widthwise and cut (2) Outer Borders to this length.

- Sew borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press towards the Outer Border.

- Quilt Bind and Enjoy!
