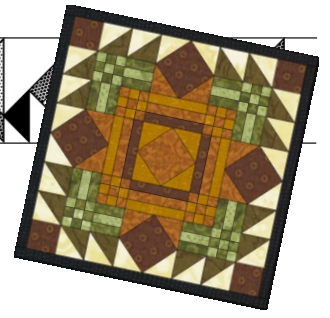

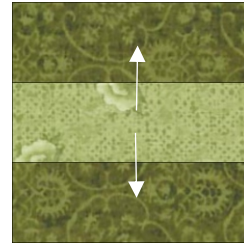


Cutting Directions (Part 1)

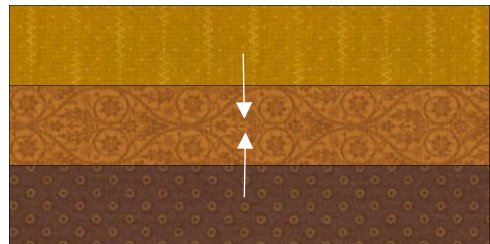
- From Light Green Fabric cut:
 - (8) 1-1/2” x 3-1/2” Rectangles (A)
 - (20) 1-1/2” x 1-1/2” Squares (B)
- From Medium Green Fabric cut:
 - (16) 1-1/2” x 3-1/2” Rectangles (C)
 - (16) 1-1/2” x 1-1/2” Squares (D)
- From Medium Gold Fabric cut:
 - (4) 1-1/2” x 6-1/2” Rectangles (E)
 - (16) 1-1/2” x 1-1/2” Squares (F)
- From Dark Gold Fabric cut:
 - (4) 1-1/2” x 6-1/2” Rectangles (G)
 - (20) 1-1/2” x 1-1/2” Squares (H)
- From Brown Fabric cut:
 - (4) 1-1/2” x 6-1/2” Rectangles (I)

Piecing Instructions

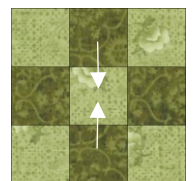
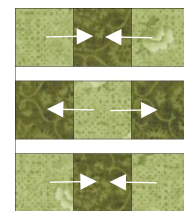
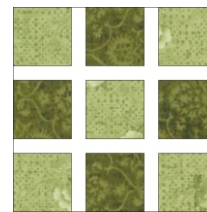
- Layout (1) Light Green “A” rectangle and (2) Medium Green “C” rectangles as shown.
- Sew rectangles together along the long side, pressing towards the Medium Green “C” Rectangles to make (1) Green Rail Fence
- Repeat previous (2) steps to make a total of (8) Green Rail Fence Units should measure 3-1/2” x 3-1/2”



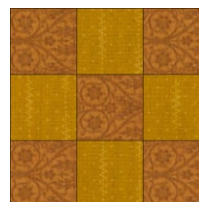
- Layout (1) Medium Gold “E” Rectangle, (1) Dark Gold “G” Rectangle and (1) Brown “I” Rectangle as shown.
- Sew rectangles together along the long side, pressing towards the Dark Gold “G” Rectangle to make (1) Gold Rail Fence Unit
- Repeat previous (2) steps to make a total of (4) Gold Rail Fence Units should measure 3-1/2” x 6-1/2”



- Layout (5) Light Green “B” Squares and (4) Medium Green “D” squares as shown.
- Sew squares together into rows, pressing seams towards the Medium Green “D” Squares.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams towards the middle row to make (1) Green 9-Patch Unit. 9-Patch Unit Should measure 3-1/2” x 3-1/2”
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (4) Green 9-Patch Units



- Repeat previous (4) steps using the (16) Medium Gold “F” squares and (20) Dark Gold “H” Squares, Pressing towards the Dark Gold “H” Squares to make (4) Gold 9-Patch Unit.



Cutting Directions (Part 2)

- From Light Background 1 or 2 cut:
 - (8) 4" x 4" Squares (A)
 - (8) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" (B)
- From Dark Green Fabric cut:
 - (8) 4" x 4" Squares (C)
- Dark Gold Fabric cut:
 - (8) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" Squares (D)
 - (1) 6-1/2" x 6-1/2" Square (E)
- Medium Gold Fabric cut:
 - (4) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" Squares (F)
- From Brown Fabric cut:
 - (4) 3-1/2" x 3-1/2" Squares (G)
 - (4) 6-1/2" x 6-1/2" Squares (H)
- Dark Black Fabric cut:
 - (2) 1-1/2" x 24-1/2" Rectangles (I)
 - (2) 1-1/2" x 26-1/2" Rectangles (J)

Piecing Instructions

- Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the backside of the (8) Light Background "A" Squares as shown
- Layer (1) Light Background "A" Square on top of (1) Dark Green "C" Square as shown.
- Sew a 1/4" seam on both side of the drawn line.
- Cut in half on the diagonal line. Press towards the Dark Green Triangle. Square blocks up to 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Repeat previous (3) steps to make a total of (16) Dark Green HST's
- Layout (4) Dark Green HST's, (1) Brown "G" Square, (1) Green 9-Patch unit, (2) Green Rail Fence units, & (1) Gold 9-Patch unit as shown.
- Sew together, pressing seams as shown to make one Corner Square. Corner Square should measure 9-1/2" x 9-1/2"
- Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the backside of (8) Light Background "B" Squares, (8) Dark Gold "D" Squares, and (4) Medium Gold "F" Squares as shown.
- Layer (1) Light Background "B" Square in the upper left corner of (1) Brown "H" Square as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the sewing line. Press towards the Light Background Triangle.
- Repeat previous (2) steps on the remaining (3) Corners with (1) Light Background "B" Square and (2) Dark Gold "D" Squares corners. to make (1) Square-in-a-Square Block. Block should measure 6-1/2" x 6-1/2"
- Repeat previous (3) Steps to make a total of (4) Square-in-a-Square Blocks.
- Repeat previous (4) Steps with (1) Dark Gold "E" Square and (4) Medium Gold "F" Squares to make (1) Center Square.
- Layout (1) Square-in-a-Square Block and (1) Gold Rail Fence unit as shown.
- Sew units together pressing towards the Gold Rain Fence Unit to make (1) Star Point Unit. Unit should measure 6-1/2" x 9-1/2"
- Repeat previous (2) steps to make a total of (4) Star Point Units.
- Layout (4) Corner Squares, (4) Star Point Units, and (1) Center Square as shown.
- Sew Units together, pressing seams in opposite directions to make (1) Nebraska Block. Block should measure 24-1/2" x 24-1/2"
