Welcome

This Quilt along is very special to me it is based off of the very first BOM I created in 2011 for Country Traditions (now Nebraska Quilt Company) where I have worked for the past 16 years. The original pattern was only my 3rd pattern ever and was in need of major edits, rewriting, and images all of which was something I have been avoiding for years! After 12 years though I've decided the best option was to revisit that pattern, and start over fresh, keeping the good parts and editing out the issues! I hope you enjoy making this quilt as much as I have enjoyed revisiting it!

Things to know before you begin

Fabric yardage and cutting was based on 40"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics.

All measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance, unless stated differently in the directions.

- WOF - Width of Fabric
- LOF - Length of Fabric
- HST - Half Square Triangle
- QST - Quarter Square Triangle
- FG - Flying Geese

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. Read through the instructions before beginning your project. All directions have been tested and are presented in good faith, but no warranty can be given nor results guaranteed.
