


“WILMA’S CABINS”

- Background 3 yards
- Binding 2/3 yard
- Backing 4 yards
- Batting 70” x 95”
- Piecing thread







Cutting Directions


- From Background fabric cut:
 - (35) 2-1/2” x 2-1/2” Squares (B)
 - (35) 2-1/2” x 4-1/2” Rectangles (C)
 - (35) 2-1/2” x 6-1/2” Rectangles (F)
 - (35) 2-1/2” x 8-1/2” Rectangles (G)
 - (35) 2-1/2” x 10-1/2” Rectangles (J)
 - (35) 2-1/2” x 12-1/2” Rectangles (K)
- From **Each** Assorted Jelly Roll Strips cut:
 - (1) 2-1/2” x 2-1/2” Squares (A)
 - (1) 2-1/2” x 4-1/2” Rectangles (D)
 - (1) 2-1/2” x 6-1/2” Rectangles (E)
 - (1) 2-1/2” x 8-1/2” Rectangles (H)
 - (1) 2-1/2” x 10-1/2” Rectangles (I)
- From Binding fabric cut:
 - (8) 2-1/2” x WOF Strips

Piecing Instructions

- Layer (1) Assorted Jelly Roll “A” Square with (1) Background “B” Square. Sew Blocks together press out towards in the direction of the arrow.




- Turn block counter clockwise and Layer (1) Background “C” rectangle onto the AB unit. Sew the Background “C” rectangle on and press towards “C”. Block should measure 4-1/2”x 4-1/2”




NOTE: You will turn the block counter clockwise a quarter turn after each seam so the seam you just sewed is at the top. Then layer the next piece on the right hand side of the block and sew.


- Turn block and sew on (1) Assorted “D” Rectangle, pressing towards the “D” rectangle.




- Turn block and sew on (1) Assorted “E” Rectangle. Press towards “E”. Block should measure 6-1/2” x 6-1/2”




- Turn block and sew on (1) Background “F” Rectangle. Press towards “F”




- Turn block and sew on (1) Background “G” rectangle. Press towards “G”. Block should measure 8-1/2” x 8-1/2”




- Turn block and sew on (1) Assorted “H” Rectangle, Press towards the “H” rectangle.




- Turn block and sew on (1) Assorted “I” Rectangle. Press toward “I”. Block should measure 10-1/2” x 10-1/2”



- Turn block and sew on (1) Background “J” Rectangle. Press towards “J”




- Turn block and sew on (1) Background “K” rectangle. Press towards “K”. Block should measure 12-1/2” x 12-1/2”.




- Repeat all Previous Steps to make a total of (35) Log Cabin Blocks.


- Layout out (35) Log Cabin Blocks as shown.



- Sew Blocks into rows pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.



- Sew rows together, pressing in the direction of the arrow.



- Quilt, Bind and Enjoy. .
