Assorted Colors (40) 2-1/2" x WOF

Border 1-1/4 yardsBinding 2/3 yards

Backing 5 yards (40" wide)

Batting 80" x 90"



- All Quantities and cuts are based on 40" wide, 100% cotton fabrics.
- All measurements include a 1/4" seam allowance.
- Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.
- Read through the instructions before beginning your project.
- WOF Width of Fabric.
- LOF Length of Fabric
- All directions have been tested and are presented in good faith.

Cutting Directions

- From Background Cut
 - (8) 2-1/2" x 62-1/2 (F)
 - (49) 2-1/2 x 8-1/2" (D)
 - (44) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (B)
 - (116) 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" (E)
- From Border Cut
 - (8) 4-1/2" x WOF (Border)

- From Each Jelly Roll Strip cut
 - (6) 2-1/2" x WOF (A) (make sure they are all different)
 - (40) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" (D)
 - (44) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" (C)
 - (80) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" (B)
 - (88) 2-1/2 x 2-1/2" (E)
- From Binding Cut
 - (8) 2-1/2" x WOF (Binding)


Piecing Instructions

- Layout (2) Assorted "A" strips as shown.
- Sew strips together, along the long side to make (1) Stripset, pressing seam in the direction of the arrow.
- Repeat, previous (2) steps to make a total of (3) Stripsets.
- Sub-cut strip sets into (22) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Unit A.
- Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of (88) Assorted "E" Squares as shown.
- Layer (1) Assorted "E" Square on top of (1) Background "B" Rectangle (Left side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line.
 Press in the direction of the arrow.
















- Layer (1) Assorted "E" Square on top of the previous "B" Rectangle (Right side) as shown.
- Sew on the drawn line. Cut 1/4" away from the sewn line. Press in the direction of the arrow to make (1) Flying Geese A Unit. Flying Geese A unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2"

(36) Flying Geese B using (2) Background "E" and (1)







Assorted "B"

- Layout: (2) Unit "A" (4) Background "E" (4) Flying Geese A as shown
- Sew units together into rows, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows.
- Sew rows together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Star Block. Star Block should measure 8-1/2" x 8-1/2".
- Repeat previous (3) Steps to make a total of (11) Star Blocks.




- Lavout: (2) Assorted "D" (4) Flying Geese B as shown
- Sew units together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows to make (1) Flying Geese Block.
- Repeat previous (2) steps to make a total of (9) Flying Geese **Blocks**
- (1) Unit A (2) Assorted "B" Layout: (2) Assorted "C" (1) Assorted "D"
- Sew units together in alphabetical order to make (1) Log Cabin Block, Block should measure 8-1/2" x 8-1/2".
 - *After each seam turn the block counter-clockwise a quarter-turn. and add the next strip to the right-hand side.
- Repeat previous (2) steps to make a total of (22) Log Cabin Blocks.





- Layout: (8) Background "A" (49) Background "D" (11) Star Blocks (9) Flying Geese Blocks
 - (22) Log Cabin Blocks as shown.

Sew units together into rows, pressing towards the Background "D" rectangles



- Sew rows together, pressing towards the Background "A" strips.
- Sew the (8) Border strips into one long strip along the short end.
- Measure down the center of your quilt lengthwise and cut (2) borders to this length.
- Sew borders to the left and right sides of the quilt. Press towards the border
- Measure through the center of your quilt widthwise and cut (2) borders to this length.
- Sew borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press towards the border
- Quilt, Bind and Enjoy!
