Why Compassionate Truth?



"Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness." Lamentations 3:22-23 (NIV)

"Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me...! am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:1, 6 (NLT) Compassionate Truth brings hope. Compassionate Truth brings peace. Compassionate Truth brings real love.

Jesus is Compassionate Truth

"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God. For just as we share abundantly in the sufferings of Christ, so also our comfort abounds through Christ" (2 Corinthians 1:3-5, NIV).





Marriage & Family Ministry

Compassionate families are key to sharing the love of Jesus with the world. One way that CTM builds compassionate families is through "6 Weeks to Oneness." A 6-week class designed to help married couples embrace God's design for their marriage.

"For this reason I kneel before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith" (Ephesians 3:14-17, NIV).

Christian Apologetics & Worldview Ministry

Faith, science, philosophy, and reality all blend together coherently, cohesively, and truthfully in a compassionate and loving way in the Christian worldview. One way that CTM builds up the Truth is through its "Compassionate Truth Group," where individuals are encouraged to bring their questions and their life stories, because: "Behind every question is a story and a MIND."

"But in your hearts revere Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect" (1 Peter 3:15, NIV)

Bible Teaching Ministry

The Bible can be trusted because Jesus can be trusted. The Bible is the inspired Word of God telling God's redemptive story of compassionate love.

"He said to them, 'This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms.' Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures" (Luke 24:44-45, NIV).



Jesus bridges the gap between God's enduring love for us and the pain we feel in this world that is broken by sin. His compassionate love, fully demonstrated for us on the cross, burned right through our sin, bringing us hope, peace, and real love.

Commitment to Communicate



Hello and thank you for considering supporting our call to ministry as missionaries! InFaith is a missionary support organization that provides a platform for donors to give directly to missionaries. Below are some various ways that you can give to our ministry through InFaith.



Web profile on InFaith's website:

The simplest way to give is through our web profile (https://infaith.org/ministries/mark-faulstich). From there, you can customize your gift and securely give online. InFaith also offers the option to set up recurring monthly donations, which can help our ministry budget proactively.

Checks sent to InFaith's address:

Another way to give is by sending a check to InFaith's address at 145 John Robert Thomas Drive, Exton, PA 19341. To give by check, simply make it payable to InFaith and include "Mark Faulstich" in the memo line. InFaith will deposit the donation and send you a receipt.

Over the phone:

InFaith also offers the option to give over the phone by calling their office at (610) 527-4439. You can speak with a member of their team and provide your credit or debit card information to donate. Additionally, InFaith offers a direct bank transfer service that can be set up over the same phone number, which allows you to set up recurring donations.

Additional Giving Options

IRA Charitable Distributions:

If you are 70 ½ years or older, you can make a tax-free gift to our ministry through an IRA charitable distribution. This allows you to give directly to our ministry from your IRA without counting the distribution as taxable income. To make an IRA charitable distribution, simply contact your IRA administrator and request a distribution be made payable to InFaith, and then let InFaith know that your gift is for our ministry (*Mark Faulstich*, *Compassionate Truth Ministries*).

Donor-Advised Funds:

Another option is a donor-advised fund. This is a charitable giving account that allows you to make a tax-deductible gift to the fund and then recommend grants from the fund to InFaith to support our ministry. This is a flexible option that also allows you to make one gift and then distribute it over time. To make a gift through a donor-advised fund, simply contact your fund administrator and request that a grant be made to InFaith, specifying that the gift is for our ministry. If you do not yet have a donor advised fund you can create one by contacting your investment advisor.
