DONKEY LANE COMMUNITY ORCHARD OX39 4PF

A project by Greening Chinnor to turn derelict land with ancient apple trees into a community orchard. Wheelchair/pushchair access is difficult.

GARDENS to explore



1 TWO HOOTS, 36 OAKLEY LANE OX39 4HT
Large cottage garden split into many rooms featuring lawns, trees, shrubs, perennials, veggie garden and an alpine bed. Wheelchair access is possible (please ask for assistance) Only assistance dogs please. Jim's Pimms available whilst you wander round. *Willow weaving display and goods.*

2 41 COWLEAZE, OX39 4TB
A medium sized garden which wraps around the house and is a work in progress, with a number of plants which will move to more permanent positions as the garden develops. The garden features a mixed planting of flowers, vegetables and fruit. It also has a double pond, one part reserved for fish and the other for aquatic life. The garden not wheelchair accessible, and no dogs please.

3 12 PILMORE MEADOW, OX39 4GA SUNDAY ONLY
The garden has been created from new, over the last few years. A typical English garden, incorporating a large variety of roses, climbing plants and perennials. There is a greenhouse and a variety of seating areas, enabling views across the garden and over the fields beyond. Wheelchair access, dogs in arms only.

4 CHESTNUT COTTAGE, 6 ST ANDREWS ROAD OX39 4HG
A colourful and busy garden with a beech hedge and fence hiding flowers, shrubs and trees. The small front garden is full of shrubs, climbing plants, roses, hollyhocks, primulas and peonies. Continue round to the patio,

pass the Wisteria, Vine and the raised Hosta display area to 2 large flower beds a lawn, a fishpond in front of a wild area, greenhouse and round the corner raised vegetable beds and fruit trees. Not suitable for wheelchairs dogs on lead welcome. *Handmade ceramics for sale.*

5 13 ELM DRIVE, OX39 4HQ
A small, well stocked back garden planted with mature trees including Cercis and Katsura. It has many interesting perennials and climbers, with ponds and a waterfall. It is on several levels so not wheelchair accessible and no dogs please.

6 4 OAKLEY ROAD, OX39 4GB
Traditional English Garden with lawns, flower beds and fruit trees. The land slopes gently down and the garden has several steps and cobbled and flint paths. On sunny days there are still shady areas and there are plenty of places to sit. We are happy to welcome well-behaved dogs but the layout makes it unsuitable for wheelchairs.

7 16 RECTORY MEADOW, OX39 4PJ
A medium size garden, once part of the old rectory grounds, with a gravel front garden. Back garden with a lawn and greenery for a flower arranger. Some drift wood throughout the garden and a pond. Back garden not accessible for wheelchairs. Assistance dogs only.

8 18 RECTORY MEADOW OX39 4PJ
A garden for all seasons relying on shrubs, perennials and bulbs to give year colour. Salvias are a favourite.

Wheelchair accessible. *On display – a knitted garden, woodwork & walking sticks.*

9 7 RECTORY MEADOW, OX39 4PJ
A small cottage style garden, totally redesigned by the new owners. Well stocked colourful borders intermingle with cutting flowers for the house. A patio with colourful pots of mature acers and hydrangeas brought from our previous home in Kingston Blount. Pretty water feature in natural stone with a 3-metre stream and planting. New Trellis fencing and arches planted with clematis and roses. Dogs welcome on leads and wheelchair friendly.

10 ROSE COTTAGE, 3 KEENS LANE, OX39 4PF
A small but well stocked cottage courtyard garden with a mix of traditional and modern. Lots of pots! Two steps access to the back garden. Unsuitable for wheelchairs and dogs.

11 58 THE AVENUE OX39 4PE
Busy cottage style gardens, front and back. Aims for year-round interest. Wheelchair friendly and assistance dog friendly. Plant sale.

12 8 KEENS LANE, OX39 4PF
A family garden with excellent views of the Chilterns and the Chinnor & Princes Risborough Railway. The garden has been restructured over recent years to include soft fruit and vegetable areas. Limited wheelchair access.

13 26 HIGH STREET OX39 4DH
Did you come in 2021/2? Compare the garden now – established borders of flowers and a kitchen garden that will have fruit and vegetables ready for lunch.

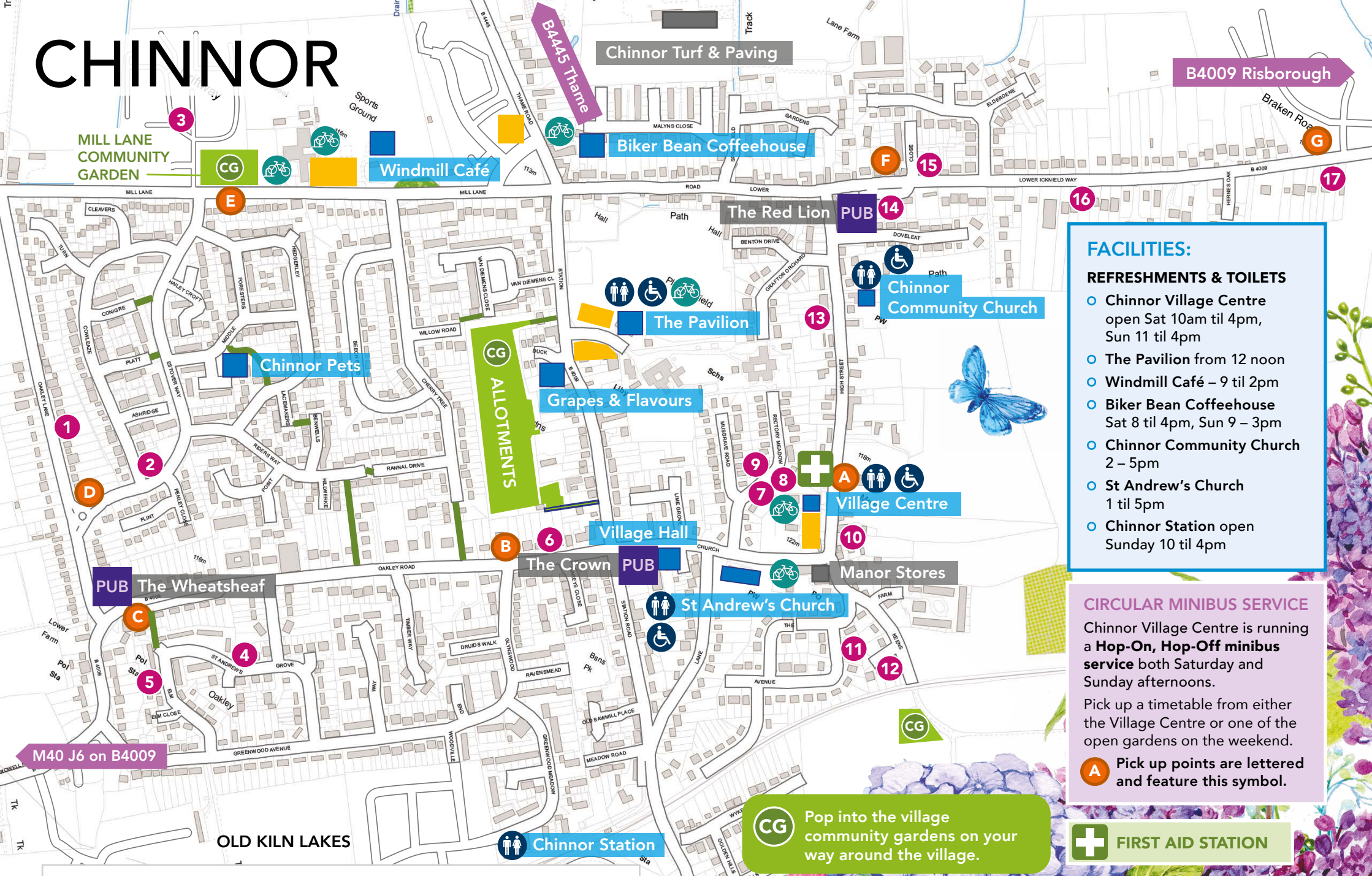
14 12 LOWER ICKNIELD WAY OX39 4DZ
A Japanese-style garden with oriental planting. Walk through the traditional Torii gate, towards a fish pond. Find a Zen garden with a pottery studio. Inside, Maxine will be demonstrating the different pottery techniques. *Handmade pottery for sale.*

15 27 LOWER ICKNIELD WAY
This very small garden is a blend of utility and charm. Small trees and shrubs create a cool, secluded area. Roses, aquilegia, and campanula offer a succession of blooms. Herbs grow here for teas. Fruit trees yield flavours for homemade kombucha. Water features attract wildlife, enhancing biodiversity. Wheelchair accessible (no dogs please).

16 42A LOWER ICKNIELD WAY OX39 4EB
Not your typical garden but a 20 ft greenhouse full of Cactus plants, mainly from Mexico and the Southern United States. The collection gained National Collection status but has recently been withdrawn. By June a good number should be in flower. The rest of the garden is laid to grass and offers a lovely view of the ridge. There is wheelchair access.

17 78 LOWER ICKNIELD WAY, OX39 4EB
Eco-friendly and unkempt garden for you to explore at leisure; featuring woodland with composting area, wildlife pond & bog garden. The wildlife meadow is a haven for insects. Raised borders, scree garden, a garden room, and more! A rainwater harvesting system satisfies our garden's needs. Seats for you to rest awhile. Wheelchair access (gravel drive and step to meadow. No dogs please.

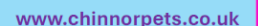
