GARDENS 1-10

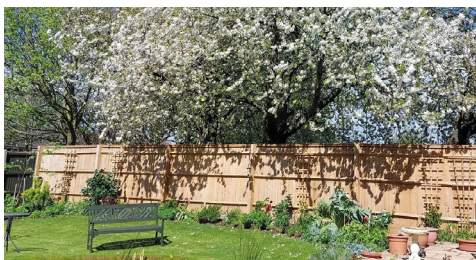


1 TWO HOOTS, 36 OAKLEY LANE OX39 4HT

Large cottage garden split into many rooms featuring lawns, trees, shrubs, perennials, veggie garden and an alpine bed. Wheelchair access is possible (please ask for assistance) Only assistance dogs please. Jim's Pimms available whilst you wander round. *Willow weaving display and goods.*

2 41 COWLEAZE, OX39 4TB

A wildlife haven in a mid-sized garden featuring a mixed planting of flowers, vegetables and fruit. It also has a double pond; one part reserved for fish, the other for aquatic life. We've seen a huge upsurge in numbers of insects and have successfully attracted a greater range of birds such as goldcrests, wrens and grey wagtails as regular visitors. The garden is unsuitable for wheelchairs and no dogs.



3 5 COWLEAZE OX39 4TD

A small garden, newly planted in spring 2025. The borders wrap around the circular lawn and patios, and are filled with sun loving perennials on one side, gradually shifting to shade lovers on the other. An interesting mix of small trees including Acer, dwarf Ginkgo, Cercis and trained fruit trees are interspersed amongst the planting. *Original wildlife art and locally printed cards for sale.*

4 12 PILMORE MEADOW, OX39 4GA SUNDAY ONLY

The garden has been created from new, over the last few years. A typical English garden, incorporating a large variety of roses, climbing plants and perennials. There is a greenhouse and a variety of seating areas, enabling views across the garden and over the fields beyond. Wheelchair access, dogs in arms only.

5 18 BENWELLS, OX39 4TU

Small but packed with interest. A traditional English garden with lawn, apple tree, pergola, flower borders, perennials, a little vegetable plot, greenhouse, and lots of pots. There is something in flower every week of the year. Some uneven paving and tight wheelchair access. Assistance dogs only.

6 15 OAKLEY ROAD OX39 4HD

The garden has been a work in progress since moving to the village several years ago. It is quite a low maintenance wrap-around garden laid to lawn with a variety of conifers and borders incorporating both shady and light seating areas.

7 ORCHARD HOUSE, 8C OAKLEY ROAD OX39 4HZ

The house sits on a generous sized, West facing plot which as its name suggests was built on an old Orchard with some original trees still in place. The garden is a work in progress with new hard landscaping around the trees, climbing Roses and Wisteria. Planting is a loose cottage garden style mostly in newly formed beds that we continue to cut into what was largely a central lawn. It's borrowed views of the clear skies over the allotments make it good for watching birds in the day and bats with the sunset. Whilst there is wheelchair access to the rear garden there are two steps down from the patio. No dogs please.

8 16 MUSGRAVE ROAD OX39 4PL

An average smaller garden having a group of evergreen tall shrubs screening the front garden providing winter colour and berry fruit for birds, under planted with wild tulips. Deep gravel drainage provides space for agapanthus, nerines and long flowering roses. The rear garden has many interesting features, as a path takes us through the planting areas of all season interest around past a summerhouse, art workshop, wildlife pond fed by roof water, arches for honeysuckle and clematis, rambling roses and stone features with seating areas. A single step rise to be noted. Dogs on leads at all times please.

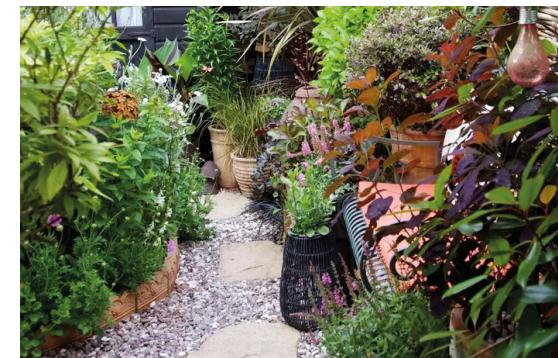
9 7 RECTORY MEADOW, OX39 4PJ

A small cottage style garden, totally redesigned by the new owners. Well stocked colourful borders intermingle with cutting flowers for the house. A patio with colourful pots of mature acers and hydrangeas brought from

our previous home in Kingston Blount. Pretty water feature in natural stone with a 3-metre stream and planting. New Trellis fencing and arches planted with clematis and roses. Dogs welcome on leads and wheelchair friendly.

10 ROSE COTTAGE, 3 KEENS LANE, OX39 4PF

All change in this recently refurbished courtyard garden full of pots! A long slim area down the side of the property leading to a small private nook out the back with comfortable seating and water feature. Unsuitable for wheelchairs and dogs.

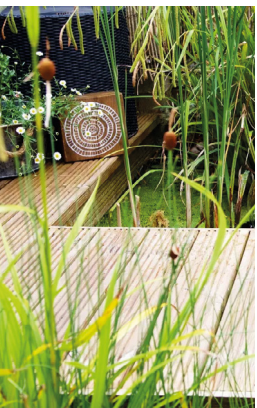
11 58 THE AVENUE OX39 4PE
Busy cottage style gardens, front and back. Aims for year-round interest. Wheelchair friendly and assistance dog friendly. Plant sale.

13 8 KEENS LANE, OX39 4PF
A family garden with excellent views of the Chilterns and the Chinnor & Princes Risborough Railway. The garden has been restructured over recent years to include soft fruit and vegetable areas. Limited wheelchair access.

14 CANDLES COTTAGE, 35 HIGH ST, OX39 4DJ
A long, narrow garden features courtyard, cottage & seaside areas with decking, a wildlife pond (+ newts), an art cabin/sewing room and a circular lawn. Grasses, perennials and hostas abound. Two patios & small circular lawn. Access is via a long alleyway to the rear with very uneven surface, so not suitable for wheelchairs or those with mobility issues. No dogs please (we have cats). *Original art, cards & handmade jewellery for sale.*

15 78 LOWER ICKNIELD WAY OX39 4EB
Eco-friendly, unkempt garden for you to explore at leisure. Woodland as you enter. Composting area. Wildlife pond & Damp; bog garden. Rain water from harvesting tanks is directed to the pond, then to the bog garden. A raised slate alpine garden beyond which is a haven for insects. Wander through the Meadow to reach a new asparagus bed and the semi-tropical garden. Eventually returning to the Garden Room. Ample seating if you wish to rest a while. Wheelchair access with 1 step to negotiate. No dogs please.

12 7 THE AVENUE, OX39 4PE
Well established south facing garden designed to be a private, peaceful and relaxing area which is easily maintained. Wind & water features. Take a seat, relax a while and maybe enjoy a cup of tea and cake. Wheelchair friendly no dogs please.



16 HEDGERLY WOOD, RED LANE, OX39 4BW
A family-friendly visit to a beautiful 5-acre woodland, complete with car park and lots to see and do. Take the **Deep Time Walk**, a transformative journey through 4.6 billion years of Earth's history.

In the 100-seat **Amphitheatre**, there will be refreshments to enjoy while watching short nature films under a stunning canopy of beech leaves.

Plus: There will be an introduction to the **Mycelium Map (www.mymap.eco)**, the innovative map that connects people who like green things with each other. You can jump to this very event on the Map via this link: <https://mymap.eco/events/open-gardens-welcomes-hedgerley-wood/>

There's a **great view** too – beyond the Golden Ball, all the way to Windsor Castle on a fine day.

Donations go to our local charity, the **Hedgerley Wood Trust**, which provides educational films and talks on climate and nature actions at the **OneClimate Centre** – as well as **storytelling sessions** where filmmakers share the subtle art of storytelling in words and video.

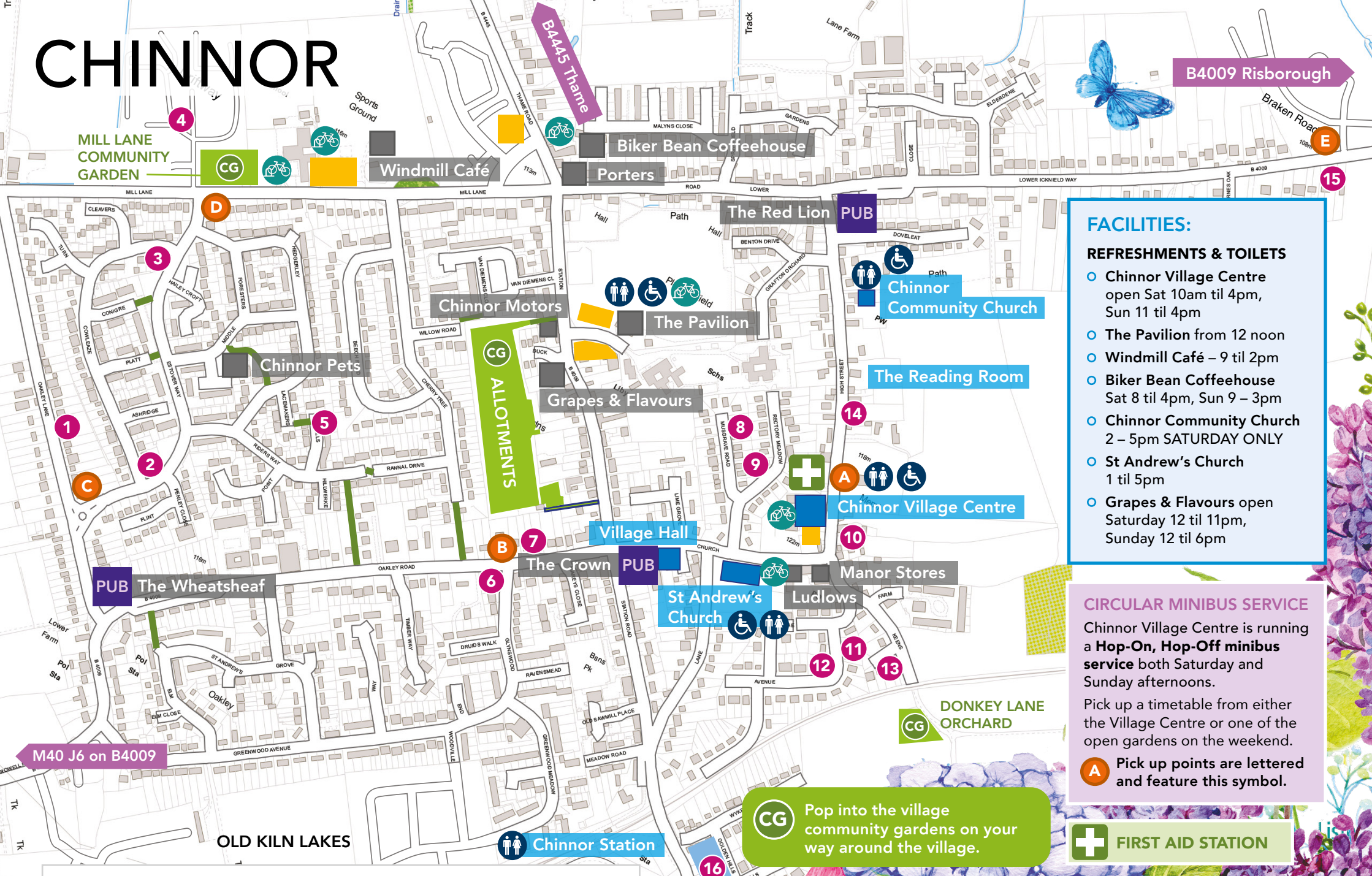
