





Some parts of the Filipino culture cannot just be changed or more so ignored such as the filipno's love for celebration, by means of celebration is no exception, it is actually an understatement as Filipinos are well known to have some of the best celebrations which includes Valentine's Day.

Valentine's Day in the country is as grand as any other occasion especially when food and family or treasuring people comes together, Filipinos most likely have their own ways of commemorating it. Typically for Filpinos, it is a day to express their feelings and begin courting someone they like. It is in the tradition of Filipinos to court someone through serenading or "harana" (Filipino term for serenade, which means a complimentary vocal or instrumental performance) using a traditional love song they refer to as "kundiman" to express how you feel to the person you like, these days any romantic love song will do.But it does not mean that the season of love is not only just for romantic relationships.

Based on studies conducted by an e-commerce company in Poland, 79% Filipinos celebrate Valentine's Day, where they buy gifts for their significant other, family, colleagues, and friends. Filipinos are known to tend to be creative in expressing their affection, they will never run out of ideas on how to celebrate all kinds of love on Valentine's Day they would even go out of way to surprise a loved one. In fact As early as the first day of February in the Philippines, street shops, and different local and even private and public establishments start to be filled with heart decorations and flowers. This only goes to show how Filipinos value relationships among others.





Lukong is also known as an income generating Farm as they offer services not limited to being a learning center for agriculture but as agri- tourist destination the place is good for a) events places b) camping (take note: there is no cellphone signal on and beyond their location) c) retreat and recollection (the place is so serene, and calm), d) firing range e) restaurant, were they offer farm to table non-preservatives course meal) f) Pick and Pay (for veggies harvesting and fruit bearing trees) and lastly they sell native pigs and chicken, the entrance fee for this places amounts to Php100/ person (a hundred pesos)

For their farm harvest strategy Sir Ruel suggested "do not plant what the majority offers "like for example if the Department of Agriculture distributes seedlings for eggplant, they would plant tomato or cabbage instead applying the law of Demand and Supply to their strategy works for them. When it comes to costing, their budget is at least Php20/ seedlings as capital. This covers labor cost , fertilizer cost and all. but during summer they do not plant any veggies and just let the fruit bearing trees provide them income since they have a lot of dragon fruits, cacao trees and so much more.

PWMDFC visited Lukong Valley Farm in coordination with Sir Jumar Refran office staff of Lukong Valley Farm, who introduced us to Sir Ruelito Calinisan, Farm Manager/ VP for Operations of the said farm and also a member of Dolores Farmers Association.





According to him, Lukong Valley Farm is a family-owned and managed farm of Mayor Orlando Calayag, and the word "Lukong" is based on the name of the place which is located at Sitio Lukong at the foot of Mt. Banahaw. The place was established in 2012 but in 2014 during the Typhoon Glenda in the Philippines they struggled. the place has been totally washed out which took them years to rebuild the place / facilities. Their biggest struggles are really the typhoon and climate change.



At the moment Lukong Valley has a total lot area of 11 hectares (we are not able to explore all 11 hectares land area, since they are in the midst of building some of their additional facilities which includes a chapel and dormitories (for OJT/ accommodation). It is unbelievable that the total land area is only being managed w/ only 16 farm people. who does all around tasks as necessarily and as possible, from Farming to Customer service and even during events. Thus some of their workers stay within the farm premises and while some do not. The family of Sir Ruel stay in the farm as they are also a close relative of the owner.







It was but a fun experience especially when you see how surprised they are with the beautiful angelic voice of the Alpha team singing the song entitled "when you say nothing at all" by Alison Karuass; the romantic excitement or in Filipino term kiligher their faces were so visible especially when they were given flowers and/or bouquets, i wish you have witness the genuine happiness through their faces

One of the most common disabilty in the Philippines is the Physical Disability which includes the orthopedic or the neuromuscular impairments that affects mobiliy of an individual. Lack or Loss of mobility fundamentally refers to the inability to move freely and painlessly. These includse but not limited to amputation, paralysis, cerebral palsy, stroke, multiple sclerosis, muscular dystrophy, arthritis, and spinal cord injury, causes of limited mobility vary greatly, some are caused by advancing age, while others might be caused by accidents, neurological impairment, or other physical inabilities.

Making the transition to a wheelchair is a very big change, however, you will soon find that a wheelchair provides users with maximum comfort and incredible independence.

Since the family has a strong faith in God, they religiously go to curch and in one of the event they have heard about the PWMDFC advocacy, helping the indigent or the less fortunate aside from the Persons With Multiple Disailities from their they have set a foot forward to take the change to get necessary help from the fundation; and thank God all the help is possible with him.

After submilting all medical requirements and a month of coordination and follow ups the PWDMFC were able to get a grant for the medical needs for Ms. Virginia, the grant wont only cover her medicine but also her check ups and labaoratory and even her surgery cause which included the fees of her doctors at Philippine Heart Center.

to date the foundation is still hands on when it comes to their need and is working on getting her a schedule for her to be able to push trough her much needed Angioplastic Surgery the soonest possible. to maximize the resources / the grant given to her as well as the time for her recovery, cause more than anything her family and the PWMDFC family is working hand and hand in praying for her well being and recovery.
