

LEARNING ACTIVITIES OF DAILY LIVING

TRAINING TO LIVE INDEPENDENTLY

One of the advocacy of THE ALPHA ENTERPRISE IS to teach trainees to live a life of independency. This is in order for them to prepare themselves to self help and later on to have sustainable livelihood training.

One of our student is Johnielle his case is Congenital Rubella Syndrome. He has multiple disabilities ,Intelectual disability due to vary small information that he can grasps due to profound hearing loss on his left ear and Moderately Severe Hearing loss on the right. He cannot talk and he has vision problem due to cataract extraction done when he was just 3 months old. Activities done by him during his first month was:

- 1) Self care such as:
- a) proper taking a bath
- b) Personal hygene like proper brushing of teeth
- c) Nail cutting
- 2) ADL trainings such as:
- a) Proper folding of clothes
- b) Sweeping of Floor
- c) Cleaning of table after eating
- d) Dishwashing plates properly
- c) Putting things in order.

Fine motor training:

- 1) Clothe's pins
- 2) Playing Sungka (Imitating number of shells per place)
- 3) Beadings with color combination

The best management for him is to follow systemized schedule per hour so that he will understand and will adopt easily. Since that he easily bored, a change of activities is encourage for him to learn new things everyday. The best reward is drinks such as juice, milk and coffee. The child is being evaluated daily for progress

A JOURNEY TO HELP OTHERS

My name is Lorelie M. Liwanag a Person with Disability and an advocate. My disability started when I was accidentally fell on a chair when I was one year old, my parents brought me to the hospital for suffering high fever and the nurse who was assigned that time injected a drug on my back that causes my being an orthopedic. My childhood is not as lucky as any one, I helped my parents earned for a living by selling mangoes. My parents worked hard for us to be able to go to school. I am the eldest and only girl and I have two brothers. I remember walking from school to our home in my elementary days when I can still walk with no crutches but during my fourth grade I notice that my right leg started to get smaller and thinner. I felt pity and sadness especially if someone is bullying me. I always stay at home and helped my mother do household chores. I grew up with no so much friends. I kept myself busy by studying and finished my college degree as Bachelor of Science in Computer Science and my challenge in looking for a job is not easy. Discrimination is there. But God didn't allow me to lose an opportunity...got my first job in an Internet Shop then worked as an Encoder in a Photo/Studio Shop then as Secretary at Phycology Laboratory 1, Biological Sciences, UP Los Baños where I worked for eight years. My former boss motivated me to be a good employee and enhance my capability to do more than I can. My first International Conference where I worked as a Secretary is in Asia Pacific Conference

on Algal Biotechnology (APCAB 2016) where I met International Scientist writer and being recognized in an International Journal of Applied Phycology and also being part of the Biofuel team in Chemical Engineering Department, UPLB. Being a PWD Office Focal Person at Municipality of Los Baños (appointed by Mayor) and a former Barangay PWD President....is a step forward for doing my advocacy... I asked myself.... what really is the plan why God put me here?...maybe to serve, to help and to be an inspiration to my fellow PWDs?...I started looking for international and local organization who have a heart to share their blessings to PWDs...my line of project...started in helping the amputee, polio and with deformities thru giving them a free prosthesis, a Bloodletting project for the welfare of PWDs, a free Hearing test, a starter fund for Los Banos Federation of PWDs, Resolution for Travel allowance for Barangay PWD Presidents, Ordinance of Expanded VAT for PWDs (R.A. 10754) implemented to Municipality of Los Baños and employment for PWDs (R.A. 10524), a Sunflower Farm at Bay, Laguna for PWDs purposes and tourism. I have so many plan for my fellow PWDs...What really motivate me? It's my motto "In God, I trust" and positive outlook in life.

 referred to as relational bullying,
 involves

- * Telling other children not to be friends with someone
- * Spreading rumors about someone
- * Embarrassing someone in public III. Physical bullying involves
- * hurting a person's body or possessions
- * Hitting/kicking/pinching
- * Spitting
- * Tripping/pushing
- * Taking or breaking someone's things
- * Making mean or rude hand gestures According to the bible, whatever you did to those people, you have done it to God. It has to stop whether it is thru social Media or in person.
