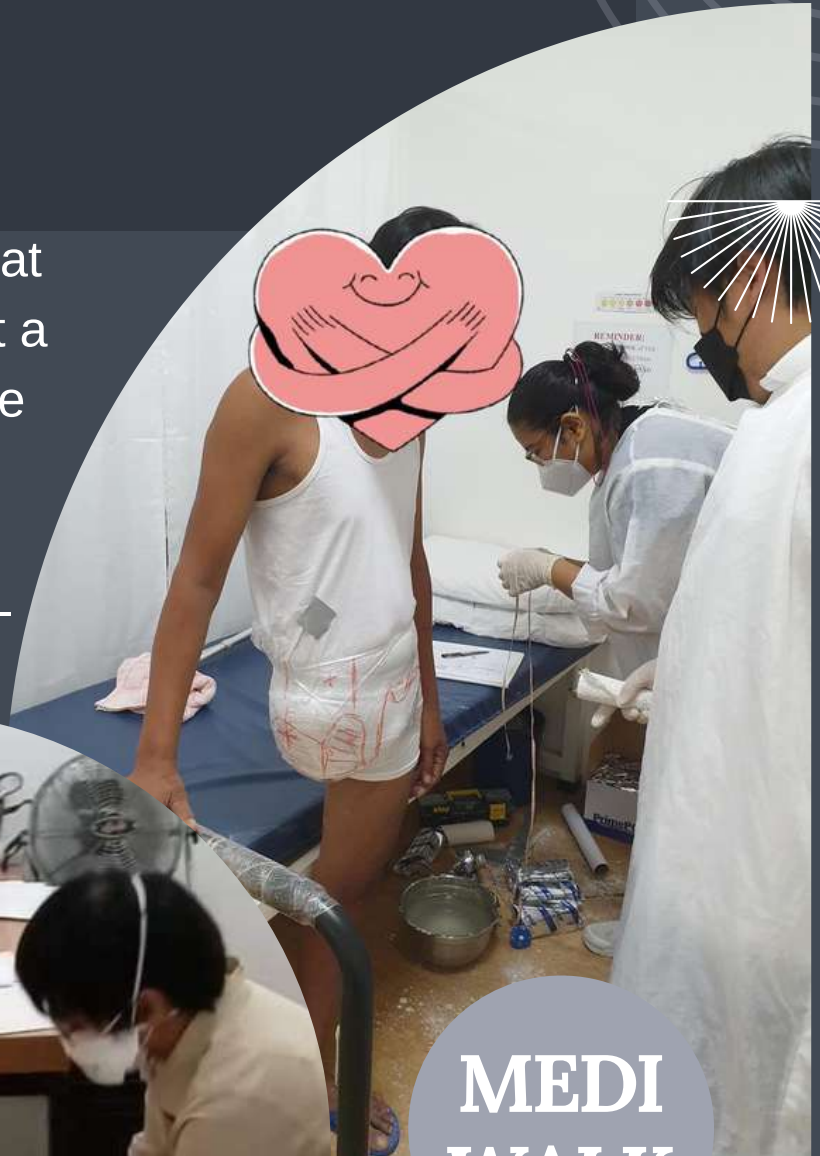


GIVE THEM FEET

He lost his left leg due to car accident for more than a decade now. At first, he is hopeless seeing himself as a useless creature. But despite of his condition he is not ashamed of having a missing part of his body but according to him, he looks it in a positive perspective that he is an able person that can still ride a tricycle to sell buko for their living. He was grateful and thankful because he was chosen to receive a device through Ms. Vanessa Peñaflor the PDAO Head of Cabuyao who introduce our foundation PWMDFC to be a partner of the Mediwalk.
