#### I am a blessed Teacher

My name is Cielo Dalde, a trainer of children with disabilities. Presently I live in City of Sta. Rosa, Laguna, together with my family. I graduated from Polytechnic University of the Philippines with the degree in BS Clinical Psychology in 2015 at the age of 18.

During my internship, I taught special children that had been a wake-up call for me. Teaching special child was very unforgettable specially the feeling of happiness when you see them learning because of you. That was the time I knew to myself that I want to be a SPED Teacher someday.

Soon after graduation I worked as a General Affairs Staff in a production company for almost one year. In 2016, I resigned from the company and decided to start my new career as a SPED Teacher at the age of 20. The Child Formation Center(CFC) in Sta. Rosa, Laguna, gave me an opportunity to achieve my goal.

The first months of teaching were not easy. You need to know and analyze the individualities of each students - the program, their likes and dislikes, their needs, the parents' expectations, and many more. I asked to myself if I can really handle all these situations- knowing the possibility that they can hurt me physically. They can also do such messy things. Parents may object to the program you're giving to their child. That question already had an answer. I am working as a SPED teacher for almost two school years now. It is not easy. But if your mind is open on what you are doing and you do it with the heart, the progress of the students will be easy because they feel that their teacher cares for them and loves them. The progress of the students is one of the highest achievements of a SPED teacher.

## Teaching Children with Disabilities gives me a true happiness

After two school years working at CFC, the Persons with Multiple Disabilities Foundation Corp. (PWMDFC), opened for me an opportunity to continue my goal as a trainer of children with multiple disabilities. I am so blessed to be a part of their advocacy and so much thankful for trusting me on my skills in teaching.

Training a 13 years old students and above is more challenging. I need to be their mother and teacher for 3 hours a day. Yes, children with disabilities will give you stress. But they are also the one who will give you reason to smile in many ways and that stress mood will gradually lessen and covered by happiness.
