- **Please submit this application via email, mail, or drop off at Chastine Property Management.**
- Once the application is submitted and the Board is notified, you may print out the **approved** Parking Permit to fold and place in the front windshield.
- **The vehicle must be in drivable condition, meaning it must have a valid license plate, no flat tires, cannot be a "project car", etc.**
- Residents with a Short-Term Permit are requested to park in a manner that does not interfere with parking related to residents attending the pool and are **not to use** the designated and marked "Reserved" spots.
- If a Parking Permit expires and the vehicle has not been moved from the Pool Lot, a warning will be sent and the vehicle may be subject to towing.
