Northwest Elementary Is a National PTA School of Excellence

National PTA's School of Excellence program supports and celebrates partnerships between PTAs and schools that work to improve the educational experience and school environment for every child. This program provides guidance to assist schools in engaging families in decision-making and helps schools build inclusive policies related to education, health, safety, or the arts.

We are 1 of 35 schools in the state of Florida and 1 of 6 elementary schools in Hillsborough County with this designation.



Based on survey results, PTA focused on helping 5th grade families ease the transition to middle school. To better understand student excitement, concerns, and questions about middle school, we deployed a survey in the March PTA newsletter and responded with resources families can use to prepare and engage in meaningful conversations with their children about all the exciting, and sometimes challenging, changes that are ahead. These resources were distributed through our newsletter, social media, and also with hand-outs to our 5th grade students.

As a National PTA School of Excellence, it is our goal to ensure that families feel welcomed and empowered to support student success, and PTA is a key partner for continuous school improvement.
