
#### **DADDY-DAUGHTER DANCE**

Still, no matter the fun times there, Brookbank could not escape the "calling" to teach. It was what she had to do. Upon graduation from FSU and with the exception of one grading period, Brookbank has not ventured far from the "Northwest Nest". Well, that's not completely true as this lady has traveled! During her summers, Brookbank explored Panama, Thailand, Japan, Germany, and the Caribbean. She even went to Mexico for 2 weeks to hone her Spanish-language skills in preparation for a class. This energetic teacher is also an animal lover and cared for rescue pugs, with various issues, for nearly a decade, pre-pandemic. At one point, she had 12 pugs in her home.
