## Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) To Be Phasing Out

Florida PTA welcomes the announcement by Gov Ron DeSantis that he, working in conjunction with Education Commissioner Corcoran and the Florida Legislature, intends to phase out administration of the FSA and move toward a system of **progress monitoring** to evaluate student performance. This will give teachers, parents, and students **real-time data** that will guide instruction to meet the needs of each student. PTA members have long held that no single test should solely determine a student's academic or work future. As a stakeholder in the process, PTA will partner to help ensure that Florida's accountability system is complementary to federal ESSA provisions and moreover serves the best interest of Florida's children.
