



## 1. General

- 1.1 You are responsible for your own behaviour and the behaviour of your visitors.
- 1.2 You must take care of all furniture, fittings and equipment supplied.
- 1.3 You will be charged for any damage caused by you or your visitors to the premises, including furniture, fittings and equipment.
- 1.4 You are responsible for keeping your bedroom clean and around the house tidy.
- 1.5 You must not get involved in, or allow, any illegal activity whilst on the premises or garden.

#### 2 Conduct

- 2.1 No alcohol or consumption of alcohol is allowed on the premises.
- 2.2 You must not possess, use or deal in new psychoactive substances (legal highs).
- 2.3 You shall not engage in any form of unlawful discrimination towards another licensee, staff member or volunteer.
- 2.4 You must not enter someone else's room without their permission.
- 2.5 You must not move, interfere with, or consume food or drink which is not your own.
- 2.6 You must not use, move, or interfere with, another licensee's possessions without their permission.
- 2.7 You must not have any parties in the premises or garden.
- 2.8 A party is defined by inviting 4 or more people to the premises.

#### 3 Visitors

- 3.1 No visitors are allowed on the premises without our permission.
- 3.2 Visitors under 18 years must be accompanied by their parent or legal guardian.
- 3.3 No visitors are allowed on the premises between the hours of 10:00pm and 8am.
- 3.4 You must not allow any person to stay overnight on the premises or in the garden.

### 4 Support

- 4.1 You must attend all house meetings as arranged by us.
- 4.2 You must co-operate with our staff, befrienders, mentors and other agencies working to assist you in the areas of the support.
- 4.3 You must attend all pre-arranged care and support appointments.

### 5 <u>Security</u>

- 5.1 You must keep the front door locked and secured at all times.
- 5.2 You must never give your keys to the premises to another person.
- 5.3 You or your visitors shall not bring genuine or replica firearms, knives, martial art or combat weapons or any other kind of offensive weapon into the property.
- 5.4 You must not keep any dangerous or inflammable goods, materials, or substances













at the premises or patio apart from those required for household cleaning in small quantities.

#### 6 Music

6.1 Music must not be played through speakers on the premises between the times of 10pm and 9am.

#### 7 TV

- 7.1 Bethel Homeless Ministry will provide a TV for the living room to enable our tenants to watch tv.
- 7.2 Bethel Homeless Ministry will pay for a colour TV licence for the house.
- 7.3 If tenants desire to have a TV in their bedroom, it is their responsibility to pay for one.
- 7.4 Please note that a TV licence is required to watch any live programmes on computers, mobile phone, games console, digital box or DVD/VHS recorder if you watch or record television programmes as they are being shown on TV.
- 7.5 We do not accept any responsibility for any fines incurred from the TV licencing authorities as a result of watching live programmes without a licence.

#### 8 Internet

- 8.1 No internet is provided in the property.
- 8.2 Internet is provided in the property for educational purposes, for helping you source volunteer opportunities and personal development.

#### 9 Smoking

- 9.1 You must not smoke in any area of the premises, except for on the patio or the back garden.
- 9.2 Smoked butts must be disposed of in the receptacle provided for this purpose.
- 9.3 You must not smoke outside the front of the premises.

### 10 Health & Safety

- 10.1 You must participate in the regular fire drills and have regard for the health, safety and security of other licensees and the premises.
- 10.2 You must allow one of our team access into your room once a week for a health and safety check.
- 10.3 You cannot use chip pans on the premises
- 10.4 You cannot use candles anywhere on the premises

#### 11 Utilities

11.1 You must not alter the supplier of electricity, gas or telephone to the premises.













11.2 You cannot install additional cable/satellite telephone or television equipment to the premises.

## 12 Rubbish

- 12.1 You must ensure that the bins are taken out the night before the bin men are due.
- 12.2 Any rubbish must not be dumped in the back patio or over the back fence.
- 12.3 Bethel Homeless Ministry believes in recycling.
- 12.4 It is important that items deemed recyclable is disposed of correctly.

# 13 Other

13.1 You cannot decorate your room or any communal areas without permission from us.
