






## WHO WAS COLONEL ALLENSWORTH



Col. Allen Allensworth, former slave and military hero, founded the colony of Allensworth, California in 1908 as a utopian community where African-Americans would achieve independence and self-sufficiency.

Allensworth is the only California town to be founded, financed and governed by African Americans. The small farming community was founded in 1908 by Lt. Colonel Allen Allensworth, Professor William Payne, William Peck, a minister; John W. Palmer, a miner; and Harry A. Mitchell, a real estate agent, dedicated to improving the economic and social status of African Americans. Colonel Allensworth (1842–1914) had a friendship with Booker T. Washington and was inspired by the Tuskegee Institute and development in its neighboring town. Allensworth hoped to develop the "Tuskegee of the West".




