Summer 2021 Club Photographic Competition Rules & Guidance

Introduction

Staffs Morgans invites all its members to participate in a fun photographic competition. The idea is for as many members as possible to enter up to 5 photos in a competition to be judged by an independent panel appointed by the Staffs MSCC Committee.

There will prizes in each category plus an overall prize for the winner. You don't have to be an expert photographer to enter or even to own a camera!

Photos taken by phones and digital devices can be just as good and are also very welcome.

Categories

There will be 4 categories and you can enter your pictures in more than one category if suitable. The categories are:

Category 1 - Out and about

This is for pictures taken on the road, at events or anywhere out of doors. All photos must include a Morgan or be Morgan related. They can include a single car or a group of cars.

Category 2 – At home.

This includes pictures of your car taken at home, on the drive, indoors or outdoors. Again, should include one or more Morgans.

Category 3 – In the family

Photographs of you and/or your family and friends with your Morgan. Pets included!

Category 4 – fun photos

Pictures taken just for fun and/or which could be used for caption competitions. Must be Morgan related (and not rude or offensive).

General rules & Guidance

- 1. All photos must have been taken after 1st June 2021 and not have been used in any other competition previously.
- 2. Entry is made by completing the entry form included on this site and by providing electronic images not exceeding 10mb each, preferably in jpeg format.
- 3. The closing date for the competition is 30th September 2021. (A further competition may be held for autumn & winter).
- 4. The contest is open to all members of the Staffordshire Centre MSCC.
- 5. Entry is limited to pictures that have not been previously exhibited in any other visual medium (eg on social media) with the exception of the Staffordshire Centre whatsapp message board to website.

Entry

Entry is simple!

To enter the competition, simply email your photos (max 5) and an entry form to staffsmorganswebmaster@hotmail.com at any time before 30th September 2021.



The Small Print

- Entrants must own the rights to their submissions but grant the Staffordshire Centre of MSCC the gratis right to use any images submitted on their website and in publicity material in perpetuity. This specifically includes any calendars to be produced by the Staffordshire Centre. Entrants have the right to exclude photos submitted in Category 3 from this requirement.
- 2. The organisers have the right to exclude any image which:
 - Infringes any law or is defamatory or libelous
 - May be considered offensive
 - Has content which constitutes or encourages criminal behavior, leads to civil liability or otherwise violates any laws
 - Has commercial content which promotes any products or services.
 - Involved activity in which animals were harmed
 - Includes content which infringes copyright held by others
 - Involved actions which breached the highway code or otherwise prejudiced road safety.
- 3. Images that have been resized, cropped or retouched for colour or exposure correction by using camera apps, photo editing apps, other software, etc. will be accepted. Digital art involving broader image manipulation is excluded.
- 4. Both color and monochrome images will be accepted.
- 5. Entrants agree to fully indemnify the organisers and bear all responsibility for any thirdparty complaints or objections concerning copyright or other intellectual- property-right infringement or damages arising from their submissions.
- 6. Entries are only accepted through the Internet.
- 7. Entrants must bear all costs incurred by entering the contest.
- 8. Entering the contest constitutes agreement to the terms and conditions stated in these Guidelines.
- 9. The organiser reserves the right of final judgment concerning items not expressly stated in these Entry Guidelines.

Please note that the organiser may elect to suspend or cancel the competition if in its judgment the contest cannot be run smoothly, securely, or without affecting the fairness of the judging due to circumstances beyond its control.
