David Flesch is the new President of Mill Cove. Fred Lavancher is stepping down.

Fred Lavancher Message - I have stepped down as President of Mill Cove, Inc. after serving for a year and 3 months following the passing of our founding member, Charlie Fox. Reflecting on my time as President, the most rewarding part of the job is working with such a dedicated and enthusiastic group of Directors. My interest in Mill Cove goes back to my youth in spending time along Mill Creek swimming and fishing. I've been involved with most of the construction of the physical improvements to the site, including: the development of the overall Master Plan for Mill Cove, the Large 40 X 80 Pavilion and 8 smaller pavilions, the Shooting Range and Storage Building, the Kinder Morgan Trail, The Growing Greener Streambank Restoration Project, the reconstruction of the Cabin Run Bridge, the site work, collection pond, roadway and parking area together with the new Charles E. Fox Environmental Education Pavilion. I will continue on the Board and serve as a member-at-large on the Executive Committee.

David Flesch Message - First I would like to thank Fred LaVancher for his great leadership as President of Mill Cove, Inc. and his many years of service and dedication to the success of Mill Cove. I will be relying on Fred for advice and guidance during my time in office. My first priority is the completion of the Charlie Fox Environmental Education Pavilion project. I plan to focus on ways to attract more visitors to Mill Cove through expanding recreational activities and educational programs. I will work hard to attract additional funding to provide financial security for the long-term health of Mill Cove. Lastly, I invite everyone from near and far to visit the outstanding outdoor playground that we affectionately refer to as The Cove.

Capital Campaign - Charles E. Fox Educational Pavillion

* The crowning element of the major improvements at the Mill Cove Environmental Area has been the Charles E. Fox Environmental Education Pavilion. Charlie Fox was the founding member of Mill Cove and served as the Board President * * for 23 years. His vision and inspiration have been the guiding light for the Mill Cove project since 1999.

The pavilion named in his memory is located in the upper portion of the Mill Cove site. Site work for the project was completed in 2020-21 by Gas Field Specialists (GFS) and involved grading of the roadway and parking lot, drainage facilities and the resulting collection pond. Architectural drawings for the pavilion were prepared by Anne Hersh Architect, AIA during the winter of 2021-22.

The Pavilion itself is being completed in phases as funding for construction becomes available. A bid-proposal for initial aspects of the construction was received from Matt Neal Construction of Mansfield during the spring of 2022.

Phase I of the building included the basic construction site grading, foundations, support posts, rafters, concrete floor and metal roof and was completed in the fall of 2022. Phase II consisted of framing the exterior walls, sheeting the gable ends with OSB, finish the facia and soffits, window placement and the installation of exterior siding (stained ash lumber milled from the Mill Cove site). Phase III consisted of framing the interior walls, apply ash siding as needed, installation of 4 steel doors, OSB sheeting on all interior walls, rough wiring ceiling lights/outlets/control box, and installing metal ceiling to the porch area. Phase II & III work was completed in the fall of 2023. To date the total investment in the pavilion is \$289,932.00.

The following items of work are planned as funding becomes available: Finish electrical work and provide a 26kw generator; Complete Stonework and Fireplace; finish interior walls in kitchen and restroom areas; Interior plumbing & restroom fixtures; Septic Tank and Leach Field in compliance with existing No. Central Sewage Agency permit; develop water well and connect to pavilion; Landscaping and exterior finish grading; new picnic tables & benches. It's estimated that these remaining work items will require an additional \$155,500.00 in contributions to implement.

The primary use of the pavilion will be for environmental education functions. It can be used for an outdoor-learning classroom for Mansfield University students, science and environmental studies classes of the School Districts within the Northern Tier, and Boy & Girl Scout and other youth oriented outdoor groups. The pavilion may also be scheduled on a fee basis for social activities such as weddings, family reunions or business retreats. At present, water supply and restroom facilities must be provided via porta-johns and self-contained water methods. To reserve the pavilion, call 570-418-3593
