

Greetings with the joy of Jesus Christ!

It seems like just yesterday we were wrapping up another year of church school and church activities. And here we are once again at the beginning!

Sunday October 7 marks the beginning of a new church school year, with new leaders, new learners, and new growth in Jesus Christ awaiting us!

Please plan to attend worship October 7 with your families. We will begin at 10am in the sanctuary. Following the Children's Message, the kids ages 3 – 12th grade will leave worship with their teachers, Sue Anderson and John Emmons. The elementary aged children will be exploring the parables of Jesus during the fall months. The middle school, high school and confirmation class will be using an age appropriate PCUSA curriculum called "Big Questions/Big God" which will focus on the promises that new members make when joining the church. It's going to be a great fall and I do hope that your kids will present as often as possible.

Because spiritual growth, like any other growth, requires consistent nurturing care and sustenance. Our families grow spiritually by being present in worship and in church school. We learn the Bible stories and prayers, we learn the traditions of the church and the stories of faith of those who have gone before us, and in doing so, we develop a heart for mission, evangelism, and outreach. The Holy Spirit touches us and our families, our children and teens, our young adults and elders, and we grow in the knowledge that Lawrence Road Presbyterian Church is *our* church, that God loves *us*, and that Jesus calls *us* to continue to grow as disciples.

So here's the word for October 2018:

- Commit yourself and your family to worship and to Christian education this fall.
- Be in church every Sunday that you are physically able. Worship is at 10am.
- Commit to bringing your children and teens for Sunday *Cool* and Sunday school and Confirmation class.
- Commit to educating yourself, too. There is Bible Study every Tuesday, Adult Seminar on Wednesday evenings, and the sermon response group every Sunday following worship.
- Make the fall of 2018 a time of growth for you and for your family. There's no time like right now!!
