

VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT for PARTISAN PRIMARY

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day (August 11, 2026) may submit a request to vote an absentee ballot to their municipal clerk. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen who:

- will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day.
- has resided in the ward or municipality where they wish to vote for at least 28 consecutive days before the election.

The elector must also be *registered* to vote to receive an absentee ballot. *Proof of identification* must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

Making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail

Contact Town of Greenfield Clerk --Deb Stott (608) 387-1214-- and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the election. You may make written application to Clerk, Deb Stott for an absentee ballot by mail, by email or at MyVote.wi.gov. Or you may apply in person at the clerk's office during the In-Person Absentee Voting period listed below.

Your written request must include:

1. your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote
2. the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different from the address above
3. your signature
4. a copy of your photo identification*

The deadline for making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is: 5:00 p.m., Thurs., August 6, 2026.

*Voters who are indefinitely confined due to age, illness, infirmity, or disability may not be required to provide photo ID. If this applies to you, contact clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

**Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election. The municipal clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before to the proper polling place or counting location before the polls close on **Election Day, August 11, 2026.** Any ballots received after the polls close will not be counted.
