

INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Sikh Inspiration Gurmat Vidhiyala (Academy). This academy aims to formalise the delivery of Gurmat Vidhiya to pass on valuable knowledge and traditions. The vidhiyala welcomes students of all students above the age of 6, regardless of prior knowledge or ability.

This academy will focus on delivering Gurbani Santheia, Gurmat Studies, and teaching various traditions such as Maharaj Seva, making of Degh etc in their mandatory classes. In addition to this, students will have the option to learn martial arts, Kirtan, Katha & Kavishri.

2024-2025 TERM DATES

Each term will consist of 13 weeks. In each term, students will be taken through 1 level in the syllabus. At the end of each term, they will be given an assessment. If the student passes the examination, they will progress onto the next level.

If a student does not progress to the next level after an end of term test, they will re-do their current level. This is not something to feel disappointed about, it is about ensuring that students are prepared for each level. The lesson structures are regimented and we understand every student learns at different paces.




VIDHIYALA STRUCTURE

The Vidhiyala is open to all students aged 6 or above, regardless of ability/prior knowledge. We prioritise excellence and authenticity in all of our teachings above all by delivering Gurmat education in the way Guru Sahib instructed, while also incorporating modern teaching methods to help students progression.

The Vidhiyala will offer several classes which students can choose from depending on their interests. However, all students enrolled in the Vidhiyala must take part in the Gurbani Santheia classes to have access to the other disciplines. The Gurbani Santheia classes will serve as the foundation for students to learn the other disciplines, where they will learn the correct way to read Gurbani, as well as learning Gurmat Studies.

At the time of writing, the Vidhiyala already offers Gatka as an optional discipline. Gurmat Sangeet, Katha, Kavishri, Punjabi/English Public Speaking, Kickboxing & Wrestling will also be added to these.

RULES & GUIDANCE

The Vidhiala will offer various disciplines for students to learn, from Gatka, hand-to-hand combat, Gurmat Sangeet (Kirtan) & Katha. However, to enroll into any of these classes, attendance at Gurbani Santheia classes are mandatory. Gurbani Santheia will form the foundation of the students learning, allowing them to apply their skills to other disciplines. The rules below apply to the Gurbani Santheia classes. Each optional class will have it's own set of rules which will be given to the students of those classes.

- 1.It is student's responsibility to ensure they are keeping up with their abhiaas. Students will be graded each lesson by their Ustaad and given notes on focus areas to practise. We expect to see gradings improve week upon week.
- 2.If a student does not progress to the next level after an end of term test, they will re-do their current level. This is not something to feel disappointed about, it is about ensuring that students are prepared for each level. The lesson structures are regimented and we understand every student learns at different paces.
- 3.There are 2 santheia classes per week, Thursday 6pm-7pm and and Sundays 12:1:30pm. Students are expected to attend atleast one of these a week. However, we strongly encourage students to attend as many sessions as they can.
- 4. Absences are only recorded if a student has missed both sessions within the week.
- 5.If a student misses 3 weeks in a term without a valid reason, they will be issued a first warning. If a student misses 5 weeks in a term without a valid reason, Ustaads will request a meeting with the student/parents of the student in which the student may be asked to re-join the academy at a time when they can fully commit.
- 6.It is the students/parents of the students responsibility to inform their ustaad if they cannot attend for a week.
- 7.If a student requires extra support, please reach out to the ustaad who may be able to offer further support.
