**Grass & Leaves**

We have a tree/leaf/grass spot North of the Hall/Village Office. Please bring your clippings up to this spot in clear see-through bags. Tear open the bags and dispose of bags in the steel bin that is available. Please NO garbage in the bags.

**Assessments** – Assessments are out. Please review the notice, should you not agree with the amount, or want more information please contact SAMA at 1-800-824-2570 or you can go to their website MySAMA.ca to see more information.

**Taxes** – Due September 30<sup>th</sup> with no Penalties. 2% penalties added on per month after due date. Final payment due December 31<sup>st</sup> before added to Arrears.

**Utilities** -

Payments due July 31<sup>st</sup>. Penalties of 2% will be added to any overdue accounts and will be compounded over each month. The responsibility is on the owner to make sure that the bills are paid. You can contact the office during working hours to check on payment, or for any questions.

**Payment Options** –

Payments can be made in a variety of ways;  
If you are coming in person –  
Cheque, Cash, Debit, Credit.  
If you are paying online or phone -  
E-transfer, Preauthorized Debit, Online Banking (Innovation Credit Union), Credit  
You can also mail cheques, however should the envelope be stamped with a date after the due date penalties will be applied.  
The Credit card payment option does have a 2% fee added on due to the banking fees.  
Preauthorized Debits have a form in the office that can be filled out. Currently only for Taxes and Utilities. Options are monthly and Full Pay (No penalties added unless payments are returned)

**What Utility Payment Covers**

**Service:** This payment covers the operation of the water plant on a yearly basis. This is so that when you get to the lake and turn the water on, you can use it. The operations include, water testing done 365 days a year (mandatory), chemicals to keep water drinkable, salaries for water operators, mailing costs for the testing (must be sent to Saskatoon), tools, and parts for the water plant operations.

**Water Infrastructure Fee (WIF):** this fee is for the maintenance & repairs of the water treatment plant building and any potential upgrades needed to the physical building itself.

**Waste:** this is the fee that was previously on your taxes. It was moved to the Utility as garbage collection is a utility and therefore cannot be on the taxes as a levy. This is the fee to cover staff wages, for this section, and Loraas disposal fee, which include the recycling fee.

**Watering**

Please make sure to follow the odd/even watering schedule. i.e. houses ending in 1,3,5,7,9 water on odd days, and houses ending in 0,2,4,6,8 water on even days. (this also applies to individual sites within the trailer courts).

Rural areas are to follow this schedule as well.

**NO watering from 12:00pm (noon) to 6:00pm.**

**1<sup>st</sup> infraction – Verbal warning**

**2<sup>nd</sup> infraction – Minimum of \$100.00**
