BYLAW 07/16

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Resort Village of Aquadeo, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referenced as the "General Penalty Bylaw"
2. "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Aquadeo.
3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction
 - (a) In the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$2000.00 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to further fine not exceeding \$5000.00 for each day during which the offence continues.
 - (b) Any fine will include the fine and any associated cost
ie: court cost, administrative fees, wages, ect.
5. Bylaw No.2/88, passed April 14th of 1988, being a bylaw to provide for Penalties for contravention of Bylaws, is hereby repealed.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on September 14, 2016.
