

**BYLAW #05/2024**

**RESORT VILLAGE OF AQUADEO**

**A Bylaw of the Resort Village of Aquadeo**

**To provide for the Establishment of Fire Fighting Call Out Fees, Assessing and Levying of the Cost of Fire Protection, Suppression and Emergency Response Services**

The Council of the Resort Village of Aquadeo in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The provisions of this bylaw shall apply to residents within the boundaries of the Resort Village of Aquadeo and residents residing or persons owning land in the surrounding area.
2. In this bylaw the expression:
  - a. “Residents” means persons residing within the boundaries of the Resort Village of Aquadeo including the trailer courts and/or those living or owning land in the surrounding area
  - b. “Council” shall mean the Council for the Municipality;
  - c. “Municipality” shall mean the Resort Village of Aquadeo;
  - d. “CAO” shall mean the Chief Administrative Officer for the Municipality;
  - e. “Surrounding area” means any area outside the boundaries of the Resort Village of Aquadeo
  - f. “Call out fees” mean fees charged by any person(s), municipality or fire department
  - g. “Administration fees” mean fees charged over and above call out fees
3. Call out fees will be charged to any resident who, intentionally or unintentionally creates or causes to create an uncontrolled fire that cannot be handled by the Aquadeo Fire Department and another municipality is called in.
  - a. Property within the Municipality shall not be charged for fire fighting costs as completed by the Aquadeo Fire Department.
4. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly to the persons who receive the service in accordance with the Mutual Aid Agreement and Fire Fighting Service Agreements as sign by Council:
  - a. for residents within the boundaries of the Municipality:
    - i. any charges billed, levied or otherwise deemed the responsibility of Aquadeo due to calling in assistance from another municipality
  - b. for residents/land owners outside the boundaries of the Municipality
    - i. charges will be billed from the Municipality for time and use of vehicles and manpower when the Aquadeo fire department is called out
5. Any individual who has a false alarm called in regarding their property shall be levied a fee equal to the regular call out rate for a fire call.
6. Should the fire department respond to a fire and then be placed on standby until such time as the Royal Canadian Mounted Police arrive, the individual shall be levied regular fire call rates from the time the fire department first responds until such time as the trucks are back in the fire hall.
7. The Municipality will issue all invoices for the fire calls/false alarms that occur within the Municipality.

  
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- 8. Administration fees will be charged at a rate of 10% for all charges billed, levied or otherwise deemed the responsibility of the Municipality and at a rate of 10% of costs billed to residents/land owners outside the boundaries of the Municipality.
- 9. The Council authorizes the CAO to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 4 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year or 90 days after the person has been invoiced for said services, whichever is earlier.
- 10. That Bylaw #02/2010 is hereby Repealed
