

RESORT VILLAGE OF AQUADEO

Bylaw No. 21/91

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR A UNIFORM SYSTEM FOR THE NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND OTHER BUILDINGS IN THE RESORT VILLAGE OF AQUADEO

The Council of the Resort Village of Aquadeo in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. That a uniform system of numbering houses and other buildings as shown on the attached map and which shall become part of this bylaw shall be used in the Resort Village of Aquadeo.
2. That all existing numbers of houses and other buildings not now conforming with the provisions of this bylaw shall be changed to conform to the system herein adopted.
3. Each house and/or building shall bear the number assigned to the frontage on which the front entrance is situated. In case a house or building is occupied by more than one family dwelling unit or business, each shall bear a separate number.
4. Numerals indicating the official number of each house or building or each front entrance to such building shall be posted in a manner as to be visible from the street on which the property is located.
5. The clerk/administrator of the Resort Village of Aquadeo shall be responsible for maintaining the numbering system and shall keep a record of all numbers assigned under this bylaw.
6. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction shall be liable to the penalty provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.

RESORT VILLAGE OF AQUADEO

Bylaw no. 21/90

A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE USE OF PUBLIC RESERVES

The Council of the Resort Village of Aquadeo, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Aquadeo,
 - (b) "Council" means the Council of the Resort Village of Aquadeo,
 - (c) "Public reserve" means all public reserves under the administration of Council.
2. Every person within the boundaries of the public reserve shall obey the regulations for the public reserve as announced by sign or other device.
3. No person shall within the public reserve, without prior authorization from Council or from a person designated by Council to give such authorization:
 - (a) light any open fire except in special facilities provided by the municipality for that purpose,
 - (b) erect a tent or park any other camping equipment or recreational vehicle,
 - (c) operate or park a motorized wheeled vehicle, with the exception of snowmobiles during the period of the year that the public reserve is covered by snow,
 - (d) cause willful damage to any sign or other equipment or device,
 - (e) deposit or store any goods, equipment or refuse,
 - (f) carry on, conduct or permit any trade business or occupation.
4. The provisions of bylaw no. 17/89 of the municipality, also known as the "noise bylaw", shall apply to the public reserve.
5. The speed of any vehicle on the public reserve shall not exceed 10 kilometers per hour.
6. A person contravening any of the provisions of this bylaw is subject to immediate eviction by a peace officer and is also guilty of an offense and upon conviction shall be liable to a penalty as provided for by bylaw no. 2/88 of the municipality, also known as the "general penalty bylaw".
7. This bylaw will take effect on the day after its passage by resolution of Council.
