**Policy Objective:**

To set Policy on snow removal after a snow storm

**Background:**

The Resort Village of Aquadeo generally has one employee during the winter months in the Public Works Department. This can be challenging when snow removal is necessary after a large snow fall. Guidance is needed as to when and where to begin the snow removal process.

**Policy:**

1. Personnel:
  - a. No person(s) will operate snow removal equipment without first being trained on equipment and signing training documents
2. Snow Removal
  - a. The Village office will contract personnel for snow removal;
  - b. Snow will be removed from the streets on a timely basis for residents and emergency vehicles
  - c. The Village office will contract a grader when deemed necessary;
  - d. All streets and alleys will be kept clear in priority order at the discretion of the foreman.
  - e. Ridges in front of driveways are to be kept to a minimum
3. Snow Removal Custom Work
  - a. Any snow removal for custom work will be completed as time allows with priority given to the Resort Village streets and alleys first.
  - b. Residents who wish their driveways cleared must first contact the Village Office
    - i. Rate apply under the Rates and Charges Policy GG-006
    - ii. A waiver form will be required to be signed by the resident to save harmless any issues that may arise in the snow removal.
  - c. Residents in the Rural may be approved from snow removal
    - i. A request must be completed in writing from the landowner;
    - ii. A waiver form will be required to be signed by the landowner;
    - iii. The landowner must have the property no farther than 2 km from the Resort Village of Aquadeo Office at the Rate set in Policy GG-006


