**Musician/songwriter Wes Jagoe on being
inspired by the stories of the history of St.
Martins.**



Wes Jagoe is a well-known musician/songwriter and composer from the city of Saint John, NB.

Wes, inspired by the challenges of history, has transformed stories from St. Martin's past into a CD of memorable songs. The song "Prince Victor" was based on a story related by a friend on the Prince Victor and the repatriation and restoration of its iconic figurehead. He performed this song at the unveiling of the figurehead at the Museum in May 2017. The history of the King's Orange Rangers coming to Quaco after the war ended in 1783 is remembered in the song "King's Orange Rangers". The tale of the wreck of the Arcana is eerily told in "Lighthouse 1885".



Wes will tell how the songs came to be and will be accompanied by Christian Murphy and the two will perform some of the songs from the CD. It will be a memorable evening.
