

COVENANT VERSE

A Command for Separation, Protection, and Inheritance

The *Covenant Verse* of the United States of Black America is 2 Corinthians 6:17 (King James Version). Adopted as a national charge, this verse establishes a clear boundary of separation, obedience, and divine reception for Foundational Black Americans.

This verse functions as a sacred command to protect Foundational Black Americans (FBAs) identity from erasure, dilution, and false attachment. It affirms that restoration is assured to those who remain set apart in obedience and faithful to the charge entrusted to the lineage.

2 Corinthians 6:17 (KJV)

Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.

Covenant Mandate

Foundational Black Americans are commanded to come out from systems, narratives, and alliances that do not belong to us and that compromise the integrity of our lineage. We are to preserve clarity in name, identity, and claim, rejecting any association, policy, or attachment that would defile our covenant or weaken our authority.

This mandate affirms that separation is not division, but alignment with divine order and ancestral responsibility. Covenant clarity is a prerequisite for inheritance, protection, and restoration. Those who remain set apart in obedience are received, remembered, and restored according to the promise of the Lord.
