MEAT Requirements / JUDGING

Chief Cooks

1. Each space with an entry must have a unique chief cook.
2. Under NO circumstances will one person be allowed to monitor the cooking on several pits. ****Violations will result in disqualification.**

Cooking Rules & Regulations

1. Only fires from wood, wood substance, or gas are permissible.
2. **ALL FOOD MUST be COOKED on LOCATION!**
3. Each team must cook brisket, ribs, chicken, or any combination of. (At least one; 50 lbs total)
4. The entry for the judging should be ample enough for 6-10 judges.
5. Each team must use the sample container provided, no other containers will be accepted, judged, or scored.
6. Sauce **MUST** be glazed or cooked onto the meat entry. ***NO pooled sauce or side sauce in the provided sample container is permitted - DISQUALIFICATION.***
7. The container **MUST NOT BE** marked in any way (e.g. a good luck kiss with lipstick, a thumbprint of the cook, pen marks, etc.)
8. The use of aluminum foil in the turn-in container is optional.

Sample Turn-In Procedure

1. See “Turn in Times” listed. Teams are expected to be on time for their sample turn-in.
2. Upon turn-in, the sample will be inspected to ensure that it is the correct type of meat; and that all rules above have been followed.
3. The container will have a random number place on it for reference by the judges. ONLY TOA BOD will know who the random number is assigned to.
4. Each sample will be randomly placed into an insulated storage box until it is time to serve to the judges for scoring.

Judging Process

1. The samples will be randomly taken from the insulated storage container and placed at the judging tables by TOA-BBQ committee personnel, who stay with the samples

- a. To ensure that the judges do not discuss the samples,
 - b. That all samples are judged,
 - c. And that the judging slips are completed correctly.
2. Judges are provided fresh plates and utensils for each sample as well as foods to clean their palate between samples.
 3. Each sample is evaluated on its own merit, not compared against other samples.
 4. The samples will be scored by 6-10 judges based on:
 - a. Sight/texture (1-10 pts)
 - b. Smell (1-10 pts)
 - c. Tenderness (1-10 pts)
 - d. Taste (1-10 pts)

The higher score is more desirable.
 5. The highest score in each meat category will be awarded category champion and the highest overall score in the final round is awarded the Grand Champion Overall of the contest.
 6. People’s Choice Award (PCA) – Cook’s Choice is judged by the people. Each wrist band has three (3) tabs on it, each tab counts as one vote. Each cook team will be given a bucket with a number on it. People will place tabs from the arm band in the bucket(s) that they like for Cook’s Choice. Do not alter the buckets in anyway. The team with the most votes in their bucket will win PCA. ***Cook teams are responsible for getting their bucket turned in by the designated time. See “Turn in Times.”**

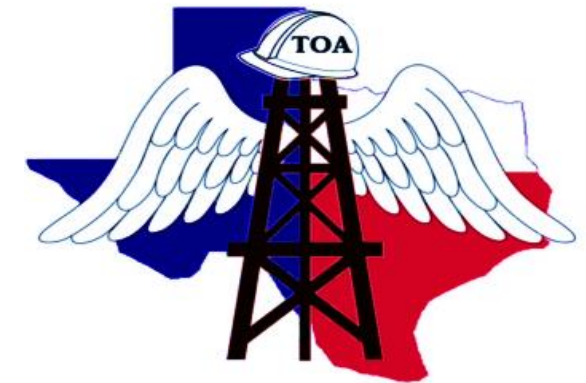
