Rules:

This competition is run under the current British Riding Clubs Handbook rules unless superseded by the rules below. 1. BRC Code of Conduct applies to all events.
2. General show rules can be found on our online entries platform –

Entries:

1. Riders are required to have a valid competition pass with the name of the horse they are competing listed on the pass
2. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they meet the eligibility criteria, the eligibility table can be found in the handbook
3. Horses can only compete in 2 consecutive classes (e.g. Prelim & Novice 0 Points, or Novice with Points & Elementary)
4. Horses may compete in more than 1 team per class, as long as they compete in different tests (ie Team A, Prelim 1 & Team B Prelim 2 etc)
5. Entries will close on Monday 5 October. Entries can be made online via the link above (please select the relevant Senior/Junior Section as appropriate and if a team entry please enter the club and team name in the class notes section) or by email with an accompanying BACS payment. If entering online each Team Manager should also email a summary of the entries made for their club [including membership numbers](#).
6. All entries, however made, should be in the horses passported name and a copy of the passport including full vaccination history should be sent by email to the

organiser by close of entry. While the organiser will endeavour to check all vaccinations prior to the show date, they take no responsibility for identifying any non-compliance in advance of the competition.

7. Passports will still need to accompany the horse to the showground and must be seen by the secretary or other designated person prior to the horse competing.
8. Any requests for times, eg if travelling together, should be made with the entry in question and at the earliest possible opportunity. While every attempt will be made to accommodate these, due to the nature of the team competition we are unable to guarantee specific times.
9. Withdrawal/cancellation/refund policy – see T&C on our online entry page.
10. Each club will be required to provide one helper for each team / 4 individuals entered. The help slots will be approximately 2-4 hours long. While we appreciate that many clubs prefer to have duties that can be shared among riders that is not always possible. Helper details should accompany the team entries / team manager's summary email, and we will try to accommodate any particular preferences where possible. Entering early will help with our organisation of this!!

Tack & Turnout:

1. All riding hats must have a visible current BRC/BE/PC pink hat tag
2. Riders wearing Exo-Body cages, must inform the official steward/organiser before the event.

Flu Vaccinations & Microchips:

Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. There is also a downloadable flu vac checking spreadsheet available to check the flu vaccination: [BRC Downloads | The British Horse Society \(bhs.org.uk\)](#) under 'Competitions'.
