
# The **Golf**

Our programme allows students to train and play golf full-time alongside their academic studies. Through our high-quality coaching and professional environment, we help to ensure that students are able to fulfil their goals on the course and reach their potential. Our students train daily through the working week with the exception of Tuesdays and Wednesdays - Wednesday being competition day. We compete in the AoC Intercollegiate tour along with many competitive fixtures. Sessions can range from; on the course preparation, to strength and conditioning sessions, to analysing techniques thanks to the golf simulator. All this is with the aim of creating an environment where players can flourish, achieve their potential, and enjoy their golfing experience.





## Partner Club



To help ensure our golfers have the best possible chance to improve and develop we have partnered with the best golf club around. Frilford Heath is home to three unbelievable course which test every golfer each round. It is also home to two shelter driving ranges to allow the ultimate place to fine tune your club skills. It also has two state of the art indoor simulators which are perfect for analysing your skills and techniques.

Frilford is a prestigious golf club which is home to many junior and adult competitions including most recently holding a regional qualifier for the British Open.

## Site and Facilities


All our students play and train at the state of the art Frilford Heath golf club. As part of it's facilities, the site offers a three incredible course including the championship red course which was recently used for The Open Championship regional qualifying. Frilford is also home to two driving ranges and two state of the art indoor golf simulators.



## **Gym at Park Club**

As we know, training on the pitch is only one aspect of the life of a golfer. Time away from the pitch is equally as important and we encourage all our students to take up our partnership offer with Park Club Gym to enhance their golfing capabilities. The gym allows players to make use of the available facilities such as the weight room, swimming pool, and have access to a wide range of classes.







## The Old Gaol

We have recently moved our headquarters to The Old Gaol located in Abingdon Town Centre. This new investment has allowed us to create another home which has benefited both staff and students. It has provided us with an extra classroom, a hub where students can improve their work and simply an environment where students can feel safe and socialise.









## The **Education**



At Procision Oxford, we provide the opportunity for students (ages 16-19) to combine full-time golf with education in partnership with Newbury College. Alongside the golf, we provide a range of qualifications to students from A-Levels and Level 3 NCFE to Degree qualifications. Our primary focus is the development and education of students both on and off the pitch. To achieve this, our tutors provide the opportunities, pathways and support for young people to help them achieve their full potential in the classroom.




### What and Where Will I Study?

Students can explore a range of qualifications around the sports sector on the programme. These include the following: NCFE Level 2 & 3 Extended Diploma (Level 3 Equivalent to 3 A-Levels), Fitness Courses (L2 Gym Instructor & L3 Personal Training), English and Maths, and the option of going onto study a Degree. All studies take place at our home bas at the Old Gaol.



#### How Does It Link To The Golf?

All 18 units of the work are delivered in relation to golf. Whether they are learning about psychology, nutrition or coaching Casey will deliver all relating it back to golf. This is beneficial as their education should give them an added edge to their golf performance. It will also provide a platform to begin to understand various job roles in the world of sport and golf specifically.



#### Where Can It Lead To?

Many of the qualifications delivered on the programme allow students to gain a taste across multiple fields in the sports sector such as coaching, anatomy and physiology, analysis, nutrition, journalism and many more. Indeed many of our students have progressed onto university to continue their studies, or into full-time employment.

## 23/34 Success



The 23/24 academic year was a brilliant one for us at Procision Oxford. We had two students achieve the highest possible grade getting 18 distinctions out of 18 units, an incredible achievement. Throughout 90 students we achieved a 97% success rate which is a brilliant achievement and way above the national average.



### **Anya Matthewson**

Anya is hopefully the first female member of staff of many to progress through the program. She achieved the best results in the classroom any student of ours has ever achieved, distinction in all 18 units. This is an incredible achievement and one that we are so proud of. She ended up achieving a Distinction Star which is equivalent to achieving three A\*'s at A levels!



#### Freddie Rix

Our male student of the year, Fred, encapsulates exactly what it means to be a Procision Oxford student. We would never need to worry about his attendance, attitude, or commitment at any stage. On and off the pitch, he worked his hardest to improve every day and lead others to strive for improvement too. He ended the course achieving a Distinction in his work, which is equivalent to three A's at A level!



#### **Degree Graduates**

This year we had 4 of our very own graduate through our full pathway. Taylor Bedwell, Casey Highmoor, Luca James and Josh Grant completed there BsC in Sports Coaching Science in the summer. They join an elite group who have progressed through our full pathway from NCFE student to degree student to now being contracted members of staff.

## HNC Coaching HND Sports Science BSc Sport & Coaching Science


These courses provide the whole package, allowing all of our undergraduates to study for an industry-recognised BSc or BA degree, with additional embedded courses, and the opportunity to train and play full time Frilford Heath.

Our offer to the students that enrol on the course with us include the following: Student Loan and Finance, Full Time Golf Training and Match Schedule, Gym Membership, Golf Membership, Level 1

Coaching Qualification.

### **Transport for Students**

We offer shuttle buses for students to and from the site every day, including to away matches. Our site is easily accessible via public transport with many bus links running regularly to the venue across the Oxfordshire area. Below are just some of the locations across Oxfordshire which have transport links to our headquarters at the Old Gaol in Abingdon.



The nearest train station to our site is Radley train station - a 10 minute drive from The Old Gaol

A bus stop is located directly outside our site which runs a regular service through the day with links across many areas of Oxfordshire, including the locations listed above.


### OFF the Course

#### **Jordan Thomas**


