Tilsley Park



The players will be coached and play matches on the first class floodlit 4G stadium pitch whilst the education will take place in the excellent function rooms and suite.

Tilsley Park offers, as part of its facilities, a UK Athletics A Grade track and field, and two newly resurfaced full-sized artificial pitches for hockey and football.

Tilsley Park is run in partnership with the Vale of White Horse District Council and is situated close to the A34 on the outskirts of Abingdon.

Tilsley Park is easily accessible for visitors. To locate the centre please follow the brown signs.

We offer shuttle buses to and from Tilsley Park every day.

Times and pick up points to be confirmed but the minibus will likely pick up in Oxford area first followed by stops along the route and transport you to Tilsley park if required.
