Pricing is set by the NDIS pricing arrangements. All supports are charged by the hour depending on support ratio. The current hourly rate for 1:1 is \$67.56 per hour. We also have a centre capital cost of \$2.53 per hour and 15 minutes non face to face time for each session which allows us to set up, pack down, write individual notes and plan for your child's goals and future supports. We usually recommend 1:1 or 1:2 support ratio for children with complex communication needs, behaviours of concern and those who experience high anxiety levels. Please contact us directly if you are unsure which support ratio is best suited to your child.

We currently accept NDIS plan managed, self managed or private fee for service as payment options. We do not currently provide CCS rebates.

All non NDIS participants are automatically supported at 1:4 ratio and daily cost is \$152.83 all inclusive.

Our fees include all materials and resources for the day as well as morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea.
