**Your Support Enables**

Early Intervention and Therapeutic Services are provided to over 270 children from birth through two years of age and their families annually.

Special Education and Therapeutic Services are provided to School Age (open 6–21 year-old) children at Happy Day School.

Vocational and Habilitation Day Program Services are provided or funded to eligible adults throughout Portage County annually.

Portage DD staff are teaching social emotional learning, expanding transition services, offering a variety of professional development opportunities, lending libraries, utilization of our gym, life skills area, and pool, to local districts. We also started a social recreation program for youth aged 12 to 17, and a short-term youth respite program.

Supported Employment Services, which locates community-based jobs, provides on-the-job training, and follow-along supports, are provided to youths and adults annually.

Transportation Services are provided or funded to people receiving the services listed above.

Service and Support Administration, available to all individuals of any age, supports people in pursuing their goals and coordinates services across multiple service delivery systems.

The Family Support Services Program provides respite, home modifications, special diets, adaptive equipment, and other supports to people across the life span living at home with their family.

The Board provides an array of Special Olympics and recreation/leisure activities for youth and adults throughout the year.

Supportive Living Services funds residential and homemaker/personal care services.
